i believe in the baptism of the Holy Spirit

Here's the 2nd installment of a 2 part Holy Spirit special by Ps Lim. Read on as he shares why he truly believes in the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

I was an active witness for Christ, even before I received the gift of tongues. I witnessed to everyone. I invited them to church and spoke up for Christianity in class. I was envious that other youth were receiving the gift of tongues before I did. One night in the prayer room, my pastor laid hands on me and told me to relax, as I was struggling too hard to receive the gift of tongues. I relaxed and began to speak in tongues till way past time for the church doors to close. It was a turning point in my life and ministry.

The baptism of the Holy Spirit lifted my perspective. I began to see things from a supernatural perspective. Ministry cannot be done in human strength but needs God's power. The intimacy of God became very real and important.

The baptism of the Holy Spirit is for self-edification (1 Cor. 14:4, Jude 20). Over 48 years as a pastor and seminary professor I have realized the absolute necessity of self-edification. If our ministry is not from the overflow of our relationship with God, we burn out and offer nothing but theory and methodology to others. We may even do the right things in the right way, but we may miss out on His empowerment.

The baptism of the Holy Spirit is for spiritual warfare. In Ephesians 6 Paul speaks of putting on the whole armor of God and praying with all prayer in the Spirit (Paul's terminology for praying in tongues). In 2 Corinthians 10:4 Paul says we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the evil forces in high places. We need God's power to defeat Satan's attacks.

The baptism of the Holy Spirit helps us to expect the supernatural. Pentecostals are fond of saying tongues is a doorway to all the gifts. Actually, by definition, to be a member of the body of Christ is to have gifts to exercise. The Holy Spirit does dwell within every believer. While it is not technically the prerequisite to moving in the other gifts, it is an empowering that frees us to trust God proactively for healings and miracles, words of wisdom, knowledge, and discernings of spirits. It is a big doorway.

The baptism of the Holy Spirit is at the heart of the evangelization of the world. According to missiology experts, over 80% of pre believers are coming to Christ through the Pentecostal/charismatic movement. Most in 3rd world countries come to Christ because of miraculous signs and wonders. The promise of Acts 1:8 that we would be witnesses to the ends of the world comes true with Holy Spirit baptism.

Hunger and thirst for all God has for you. Don't settle for less. Be like the Psalmist David who says "as the deer pants for the water, so my soul longs for you." First, quiet your heart from the busyness of life. Then focus on praising God in your thoughts, actions, words. Open your mouth and sincerely love the Lord verbally. Relax in His presence. Soak in the presence of God. Realize your mother tongue is limited when it comes to worshipping Almighty God. Realize the tongue is the hardest member of the body to control. Give the Lord control over your tongue. God will touch your tongue and your lips. You may start out with only one syllable or two. But remember, the gift of tongues is the language of praise. The two syllables could be the equivalent of "praise God." Love God with the syllables God give you. Don't try to be overly analytical, just praise. You'll be amazed, it is a simple step of faith to speak forth what God gives you!

What's the best gift you can give to your spouse? 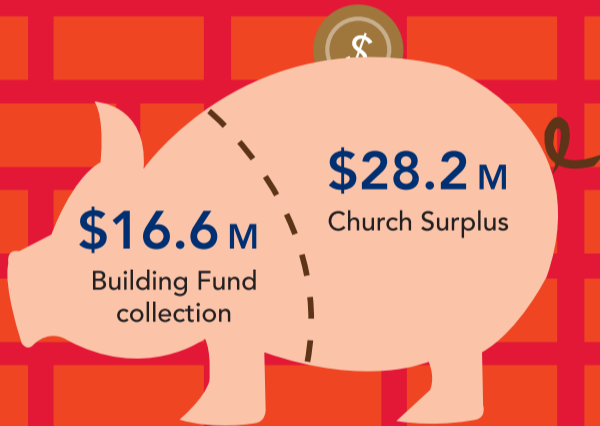

LEADERS RETREAT

R-AGE Youth Ministry organises a Leaders' Retreat for all of its leaders in December each year; the most recent retreat, organised on the 26-28 December 2013. It was organised by Sis. Jolene Lee and her committee of four youth leaders. A total of 106 youth leaders were present.

The camp focused on three roles to model after, in doing the work of God's Kingdom, that of a soldier, an athlete and a farmer, all found in the theme verse - 2 Timothy 2:3-6:

"Endure suffering along with me, as a good soldier of Christ Jesus. Soldiers don't get tied up in the affairs of civilian life, for then they cannot please the officer who enlisted them. And athletes cannot win the prize unless they follow the rules. And hardworking farmers should be the first to enjoy the fruit of their labour."

Through various activities, R-AGE leaders learnt what it meant to play these three roles:

First-year leaders went through an initiation that included different experiences, created to teach crucial leadership lessons. Debbie Lee, a first year cell-leader, relates her experience:

"[We] walked/ran a three-legged race, which was more of a waddle, and even fed each other prata. From these activities we each took away something, be it about caring for our cell kids or working together with our co-CLs."

As the retreat progressed, R-AGE leaders went through activities that taught how a soldier is focused, and does not meddle with civilian affairs. Messages from across the pulpit also zoomed in on the discipline of an athlete competing in a race. The rules set before him are not there to limit him but give him a framework for success.

It was a time to give thanks for God's faithfulness through 2013, and all R-AGE leaders sat down to a sumptuous feast, like hardworking farmers enjoying fruits of their labour. The dinner was rounded up with a segment to thank and bid farewell to outgoing leaders who have faithfully served R-AGE.

The camp then concluded with two significant experiences for any leader in R-AGE: corporate intercession for the ministry - each cell, community, and ministry - and the signing of a leadership covenant, for each leader to commit himself or herself - his time, his heart, and his lifestyle - to leadership.

Sean Lew (16), also a first-year cell leader, shares: "I realised that while the leaders of the world are often smart, rich and powerful, the leaders of Christ [are] require[d] to give their seconds and minutes humbly to God."
