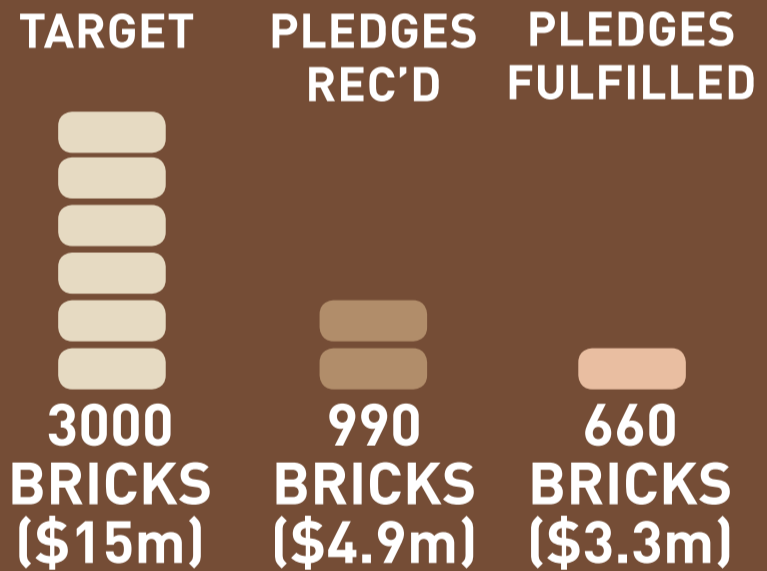

It happened many times till he could no longer take it, he left me. I know this was a lesson from God to teach me but I could not pull myself through this darkest period of my time. I have been crying and I was really in pain. The Bible said that we should confess our sins and seek for forgiveness. I texted him to apologise and I knew my mistakes now. Please help me through this.

### Reply from Alicia Poon, Counsellor, REACH Counselling Associate Counsellor.

Everybody gets angry at times which is very normal. Anger is a natural and functional response to perceived threats. However, a person with frequent outbursts resorting to violence, as in your case, particularly to a dear and loved one, is destructive anger. It is therefore necessary for you to identify the cause of your anger. It could be a reaction to other discomforting feelings of threat. I would suggest that you try to identify the primary feeling behind your anger. It may be that you are feeling hurt, misunderstood, disrespected, or frustrated. When you identify this primary feeling, it will help to guide your action plan to resolve the anger. As you rightly said, your short and hot temper plus violent behavior have driven a wonderful boyfriend away from you. Hence, it is therefore important that you start learning to restrain yourself and to retrain your approach to future similar situations is a mature way forward to a calmer life. Some steps for you to consider:

- ◆ **Realize when you're about to have an outburst.** A lot of times, people can feel themselves getting ready to have an outburst. The quicker you realize this, the more time you have to prevent it. Physical signs include: tensed muscles, your heart-beat racing, pitch of your voice changes etc
- ◆ **Notice your emotional reactions and your actions.** There are more giveaway signs of anger and a potential outburst shown in feelings and reactions. If you can learn to spot these, you can learn to quell your anger faster. Some of these signs include: Feeling upset, resentful, guilty, terrified, wanting to hurt someone etc.
- ◆ **Physically restrain yourself.** If you're speaking to someone and ready to burst, don't say anything. Hold your breath. Sit down and take a deep breath. It sounds old school and simple, but it usually works. As you focus on your breathing, the angry feeling would begin to subside. Pray.
- ◆ **Know your triggers.** If there are certain things that you know bother you or that you can't accept what they are, take steps to avoid them.
- ◆ **Acknowledge your mistake.** As you have actually hurt someone physically and emotionally, you must apologize although I understand he may not want to be in touch with you again. The more you reflect upon yourself and acknowledge your responsibility, the less you will find yourself getting into these situations in future.

Lastly, I would suggest that you consider seeking professional help in dealing with emotional issues that led to your anger outbursts.

## Daytime Bible Study for Men in Marketplace

During the months of March and April, a group of 23 men came together for great times of Bible studies. This band of brothers gave up their lunchtimes every Friday for this inaugural series of daytime Bible study for men in the marketplace.

Our Senior Pastor, Pastor Calvin Lee, led the Bible Study, focusing on the Book of Job in this series. The study was thought-provoking and the discussions brought fresh insights. As participant Randy Teo reflects, "The main take-away from the Book of Job is that God does not have to answer to anyone for what He does or does not do. Job's experience teaches us that I may never know the specific reason for suffering, but I must trust in our sovereign, holy, righteous God. His ways are perfect (Psalm 18:30). Since God's ways are perfect, I can trust that whatever He does—and whatever He allows—is also perfect. I can't expect to understand God's mind perfectly. He reminds me, "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways. . . . For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts than your thoughts" (Isaiah 55:8-9)."

Other than being nourished with the Word of God, it was an opportunity to develop meaningful brotherly relationships and providing mutual prayer support. Many participants echo Hock Lin's thoughts, "The fellowship and getting to know other brothers is a definite plus. We attend church and our respective cell groups and rarely have the opportunity to meet other brothers-in-Christ in the setting provided. It is indeed a good platform to get to know more people in a big church and also for sharing the wonderful love and grace of God".

The planning for the next series of Bible study for second half of the year is in progress. Watch out for the announcements if you are keen as places will be limited.

**RCSS HIGHLIGHTS**

By the grace of God, all three services of RCSS namely REACH Family Service Centre (REACH FSC), REACH Youth (RY) and REACH Counselling (RC) have done well in reaching out to needy families, youth-at-risk and in strengthening marriages. Here's a summary of the impact we made in 2013:

- RCSS counselled 2,450 families, 100 youths-at-risk and 500 couples
- 92% of REACH FSC clients continued to maintain well after 6 months from case closure
- 73% of REACH Counselling clients met their goal set for seeking counselling
- REACH Youth journeyed with about 300 youths who were at-risk and feeling aimless in their lives, and harnessed their strength into positive "baby steps" towards their own future

We would like to thank all our volunteers, donors and partners for their unceasing support. Please continue to partner us as we enlarge our footprint towards Shunfu and Bukit Batok in 2014.
