

A comprehensive study targeted for both beginning and veteran speakers in the art of public speaking and communication. Students will be taught the SCORRE system – a creative and relevant communication model used by leaders to effectively penetrate today's culture.

Dr Randal Langley, D Min, is the current president of Christian Life Educators Network-Christian Life School of Theology Global. He has served as Vice President of Beacon Institute of Ministry, Columbus, GA, National Conference Speaker, Bible School Teacher, Television Host and Senior Pastor of Evangel Cathedral, Spartanburg, SC.

APRIL - JUNE (SELF-DIRECTED STUDY VIA DVD/VIDEO)

Students who registered for the self-directed study of a 3-credit module are required to complete it within 3 months. An examination will be held after the completion of the module and the assignments.

BINT555: THE BOOK OF ACTS: THE SPIRIT & THE MISSION OF CHURCH (ELECTIVE)

A study of the beginnings and expansion of the early church, with particular attention given to the role of the Holy Spirit, the missional and apostolic ministry.

BIBT425: APOLOGETICS (ELECTIVE)

This course is designed to introduce students to apologetics, a branch of theology, that provides answers for the truth claims of Christianity. Attention is given to the biblical worldview compared to other worldviews and the historical trustworthiness of the Christian Scriptures.

DARE TO BELIEVE GOD FOR MORE ...

Our church has embarked on a journey of faith since we moved out of GI for redevelopment of the old building at Tanglin Road. And now we are stepping back into a brand-new building debt-free! We can truly identify with what Pastor Calvin said: "This is God's faithfulness and grace to us – All glory to our God!"

God is faithful indeed, not only in our redevelopment project but also in our FamilyLife@Grace. My journey of faith started when I took on this ministry. The ministry was birthed in the midst of redevelopment when facilities and resources were limited. Though the ministry was at its infancy stage at that time, our team trusted God in His faithfulness and did not allow these limitations to hinder us from growing.

This year, our total sign-ups for *Lovers' Retreat* almost doubled. Steven with his team in Married Life, started organizing this retreat for married couples in Grace Assembly last year. Since then there has been a growing awareness among married couples to invest more in their marriages. Through our Marriage Partners' Training Programme, more Marriage Partners are being raised to partner married couples in their journey and to mentor those getting married. In Restored Life, ministry workers are raised and trained to minister healing by using the Restoring the Foundations (RTF) model. Tricia with her team launched their first Restored to Wholeness Seminar in March and the second one was held in July this year. This seminar provided a good understanding to how Christians can live victorious lives and be free from their spiritual baggages. We received many encouraging testimonies, testifying their new found liberty in Christ and also the breakthroughs for them and their families. For Parenting Life, Frank and his team held a Family Movie Matinee 'Heaven is for Real'. This was done in conjunction with our sermon series 'Be the Gospel' so as to give our families the opportunity to be missional. We had more than 800 people signed up for the event. Many invited their other unsaved families. The Sanctuary at GII Bukit Batok was almost filled up. We believe that seeds are sowed and in due time there will be a great harvest. God is indeed touching families in

God amazes us in what He can accomplish when we dare to trust Him. With a bigger building and more facilities in GI, we are believing God for more souls saved, more lives set free, more marriages thriving, and more families transformed. Next month, *Married Life* will have the opportunity to hold their "Celebration of Marriages" in the new premise. There in the new Sanctuary, we will see 180 couples have signed up walking down the aisle to renew their vows – testifying to their commitment to leave a Godly legacy of faithfulness.

After our successful launch in June this year, members with a passion to build families are coming forward to serve alongside with us, suggesting new initiatives to further empower families in our church. We are excited! Next year, *Parenting Life* will be rolling out our Parenting Discipleship Programmes for parents with young children as well as for parents with teens. For fathers, we hope to empower them to grow in their spiritual headship through events like Father-Son Camp and Father-Daughter Date. For single parents, we are exploring the possibility of starting a single parent support group. For families with a passion in missions, we will be organizing Family Missions Trips to enable them to experience what it means to serve as a family in the missions field. Married Life will continue to enrich marriages through their Lovers' Retreat. We will continue to empower couples to grow their marriages through their regular lovers' connection meetings. With a growing number of young married couples, they are looking into training more marriage mentors and partners. Now with the availability of counselling rooms at GI, we are able to provide conducive environment for members seeking help to restore their lives - through Reach Counselling and Wholeness ministry. Next year, *Restored Life* plans to have up to three Wholeness Seminars to cater to the growing number of members seeking help. There will also be quarterly RTF Essential Teaching Seminars to empower them in their walk with our Father God. With the setting up of a new library at GI, *Life Resource* is also embarking on some new initiatives to increase readership and encourage more members to make full use of our resources to deepen their walk individually and as a family. These exciting initiatives are awesome but, at the same time, they put our faith to the test. These are faith goals and require us to trust God to provide the workers to bring these initiatives to pass.

Do pray with us! The Holy Spirit is speaking, and I challenge you to come on board with us. Come, join us in this faith journey!

SPIRIT-LED MISSIONS

The past month has been particularly amazing. When I was in India, I have seen the lame start to walk, the deaf hear, and many others come to accept the salvation offered by Jesus — all these on a daily basis! If you think the Christian life is boring, you ought to go out with Grace Missions into the field for just a few days. You will find out it is not only exciting, but rigorous and challenging!

Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid." "Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." "Come," he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?" - Matthew 14:27-31

When Apostle Peter responded to the call of Jesus to step out of the boat, notice how his focus was on Jesus first. He walked on water! It was later that when he saw the wind and the waves, he became afraid and started to sink. Today, Jesus is calling us all the same. If we want to experience Jesus and know the heart of God, we do so via the Holy Spirit.

To experience the Holy Spirit using you in the supernatural, you will need to know that what you do is not so much a matter of wisdom, as in whether where you go and what you want to do is wise and correct or not - it is more a matter of obedience to the Word of God. For the Word of God is wisdom (Proverbs 2:6). If the Word of God says it, then it must be true. The Bible says in Matthew 28:19 "go and make disciples of all nations", and then if you want to experience God, go into the nations!

We are entering the last quarter of 2015. This is the time where many teams will be going out into the missions field. I personally know some of these trippers. I understand that for some of them, they would rather go for missions trips and forgo their yearly holidays. What an encouragement to Grace Missions to see Gracians going out with such a missional attitude! So you will see that in this month alone, there are 10 teams going out into the missions field. Keep them in prayer!

FEATURED MISSIONS WORKER LONNIE CHIANG

I've been a Christian since 1974. Currently, I am serving as a bassist with the Creative Arts Ministry (CAM) in Grace Assembly. Apart from serving in Grace Assembly, I am also involved in full-time ministry with Singapore Youth For Christ (SYFC) for the past 28 years.

SYFC exists for the sole purpose of youth evangelism, reaching out to all the different kinds of youth for Jesus. We hold strongly to the caption that "if we don't win their hearts today, they'll break our hearts tomorrow". I started first as a volunteer in SYFC and then became a full-time worker thereafter.

Young lives matter. I strongly believe the need to reach out to our youths, as the adolescent years are some of the most impressionable years. These years mark insurmountable growth both physically and psychologically. The great philosopher Aristotle once said that

teenagers appear "fickle in their desires," which are as "transitory as they are vehement." Therefore, we need to help them see that Christ is the only way in their lives. It is of utmost importance to plant that seed in their lives before they fall into the wrong track.

During my first 25 years of serving in SYFC, I was doing direct youth evangelism. I was the team leader and together with 30-40 other equally enthusiastic volunteers, we did street evangelism. We gave out flyers at bus-stops near the school gates, connected and befriended students at fast food joints, went on short missionstrips, planned all sorts of small-medium-large scale evangelistic activities and conducted evangelistic Bible studies, all for the purpose of bringing the good news to our youths. We left no stones unturned when reaching out to them with the Gospel.

However, as age catches up, I no longer have the energy that I once used to have. Despite that, there is still a place for youth evangelism in the older me! In the subsequent years, I continued in SYFC by taking supporting roles like managing the IT systems and events administration. Just as the body has different parts and functions, everybody has a role to play in youth evangelism. Youth ministry is adults business too! I seek for your prayers to keep the passion burning for the work of reaching our youth for Christ and for them to be willing to be used by God to change the world!

LEARNING TO MOVE IN THE SPIRIT BY DR CHOW MINYANG

Dusty roads, the incessant blaring of the horns and the aroma of spices were a warm welcome back to India. Much has changed since I last stepped foot there six years ago, but His love for the people remained unchanged. It was a physically gruelling week, but what I sacrificed in the flesh, I in turn, gained spiritually and emotionally!

Matthew and I were in Hyderabad India, for a supervisory trip where encouraging and supporting our missions' partner and church planters were some of the top priorities. It was heartening to meet with these giants of faith, men and women who have sacrificed much for the kingdom of God. The fruits of their labour, in the 99 churches planted, were testament to how God multiplied their five loaves and two fishes.

Throughout the trip, God's presence was clearly evident – from how He withheld the rain during all our ministry days during the supposed monsoon season, to the miraculous healings, the demons cast out, and through His tangible love for His people. As I ministered in the villages, I remembered being overcome repeatedly by waves of His compassion for His sheep,

gales of His amazing love that left me weeping over His children as I prayed over them.

Being medically trained, I am one who initially doubted the veracity of supernatural healing. After preaching one night, I gave a call for healing to the congregation. A lady stood up with complaints of constant back pain for the last two years. When I asked her to bend forward, she was hesitant as the pain was great. The congregation stretched out their hands, and we



prayed. The pain got better. We prayed again and the pain resolved. She could bend down and touch her toes. If only you could see how joyous she was. Her pain which plagued her for two years was gone!

Faith is foolishness in the sight of the world, but I choose to believe that our God heals! My medical training always leaves me with doubt, but I want my faith in God to override that. I want to be foolish because I want to see God open blind eyes and deaf ears. Faith is stepping out and doing something foolish in the sight of man, trusting fully in God for the supernatural.

When I gave the call for healing, I threw away my medical know-it-all and trusted that God would heal. He will defend His own Name when I claim His promises by faith. Without faith, it is impossible to please God. Through this faith-stretching experience, I gained much more than I imagined.

There is much work to be done in India, many have yet to hear of Jesus. I am forming a team of young medical professionals to head out, God willing, in late 2016 for medical outreach camps. It is my prayer that through this effort many of those who seek physical healing will be directed to Jesus, the Great Physician.

Life on earth is short and I encourage every one of us to do what is treasured in eternity. When we give our five loaves and two fishes, miracles happen!


