WEST KALIMANTAN MISSIONS TESTIMONY

From the 28 June to 5 July, we, a team of 7 youth leaders preached the Word, loved His people and shared the Gospel in West Kalimantan, Indonesia. We ran a 3-day youth camp in Pontianak, the capital of West Kalimantan. The theme of the camp was "Take the Step" based on the story of Jesus healing the paralysed man in John 5. During the camp, we ran workshops, preached sermons and performed a skit for over 250 youths from different churches assembled for the camp.

A highlight of the camp was the Sons and Daughters Ministry where we separated the boys and girls into two gender specific groups and ran unique workshops for each group. It was a powerful time as it gave us the space and privacy to minister to the unique needs of the boys and girls as well as the chance equip them to be godly man and woman. During the services in the mornings and evenings, there was joy and celebration, but there was also brokenness and repentance in His presence. Throughout it all, God was evidently changing the hearts of the campers and they were touched by the Holy Spirit. We ended the camp commissioning the youths to be the light of the world. It remains our prayer that the Lord will continue working through their lives and the churches represented.

After the youth camp, we travelled down to Singkawang and preached at two adult services. Despite last minute changes, God remained ever faithful as the team followed in His obedience. Testimonies and sermons were shared and we even led a short worship session in Bahasa Indonesia (only by His grace alone are things like that possible!). It was a beautiful moment as we united our hearts with the locals and raised our praises to God in their local language. I was immensely blessed by their passion and service to the Lord and greatly encouraged by their desire to receive from God.

We rounded up the last day of ministry conducting a children's programme and visiting the houses of a few pre-believers. At one point, due to the language barrier, we had to do a three-way translation to get our sharing and prayers across! However, more amazingly, the Lord opened the doors for salvation and healing testimonies to be shared to these pre-believers.

During the entire length of the trip, we were accompanied by Brother Caleb Khoo, a Grace Missions missionary based in West Kalimantan. He gave us a glimpse into the life of a full-time missionary and the challenges and blessings that come along with the calling. It was a valuable experience to learn from and it deepened my understanding of seeking first the kingdom of the Lord and His righteousness. It was such a privilege and humbling experience to see the sacrifices he, his wife and two children make to serve the Lord. I hope they were as blessed by our presence as we were by theirs.

Along the journey, we faced many obstacles including sickness and delayed flights. However, these challenges only highlighted God's provision and protection. As the youngest in the team, it was humbling to witness my spiritual brothers and sisters seek the Lord for His direction, even in the uncertainty. It was evident that nothing could deter the truth from reaching His people.

FOUNDER & PASTOR, BILL WILSON CHILDHOOD

Abandoned on a street corner by his mother at the age of 12, Pastor Bill waited for her at that corner for 3 days. She never came back. A Christian layman stopped and picked him up. This gentleman bought him a meal, and paid for him to attend a Sunday School camp, where he gave his life to Christ and started his incredible walk with God – one that would change thousands of lives.

MISSION TO HELP HURTING CHILDREN

Pastor Bill developed a heart of compassion for suffering children everywhere and he knew from his own experience that the emptiness and pain could only be filled by the love of Christ. Starting with a van full of needy children in Florida as a teen, Pastor Bill eventually conceptualized and developed several bus ministries in the United States. Every week, thousands of needy children would be picked up and brought to church to participate in a unique Sunday School program that incorporated music, games and the Gospel.

FOUNDING OF METRO WORLD CHILD

Pastor Bill established Metro World Child (formerly Metro Ministries) in 1980 in what was one of Brooklyn's roughest neighborhoods, most commonly known for its history of gang violence, crime, drugs, and poverty. Pastor Bill has been beaten, stabbed and shot in the face. Yet, through all the difficult times, he persevered and refused to leave the area or give up on the children growing up in such an environment.

Pastor Bill's unique concepts of outreach and Sunday School programs, are now replicated globally. What started in a small church on a corner in Brooklyn has now grown into an international ministry that reaches over 150,000 children every week around the world in missions such as Kenya, the Philippines, South Africa, India, Indonesia and Haiti.

Today, now Dr. Bill Wilson, Pastor Bill is an author of several books, including his bestselling autobiography, 'Whose Child is This?' He also travels extensively, frequently receiving invitations to churches, conferences, television and radio programs.

MISSING VERSES FROM OUR BIBLE?

There have been numerous messages circulating for some time now claiming that the publisher HarperCollins had removed 45 complete verses and 64,575 words from the New International Version Bible (NIV) — as compared to other versions, such as the King James Bible. In addition, many people have also asked why the newer translations of the Bible like the New American Standard and New Living Translation have similar missing verses. Some examples are John 5:4, Acts 8:37, 1 John 5:7 and Mark 16:9-20. Some of these verses have been placed in footnotes instead.

There is no plot or conspiracy to compromise or undermine the Word of God. It is the result of very conservative scholars and translators to give us the most accurate translation of the Bible possible. The KJV was translated in 1611. In the last four hundred years we have found another three thousand over manuscripts that date back within a hundred years of the originals. The modern translators compared the manuscripts the KJV was based on with these older and more reliable manuscripts and found that many words, phrases, and even sentences were either intentionally or accidentally added to the later manuscripts. So, the newer translations remove these verses or place them in footnotes or in the margin to make the Bible closer to the original writings of the New Testament.

It is important to note that these omitted verses are of relatively minor significance. They do not change the core themes of the Bible nor any of the doctrines of the nature and character of God, of Jesus' death, burial and resurrection, of Christ as the only way of salvation, and of the reality of sin and redemption, heaven and hell. Rather, we are confident that our modern translations have at least 95% accuracy of the original manuscripts.

The Holy Spirit is the Author and Preserver of God's Word. Let us give thanks that we have His precious words of life for daily walk, our spiritual growth and our inner life transformation. May we meditate on them and take great delight in His Word!

It is an exhausting joy and I remember as a mother myself, I was so caught up with cleaning, washing, cooking, feeding, keeping an eye, running with a crawling child, following and making sure my child doesn't fall, doesn't get hurt. It was the loveliest age and the children looked so adorable but for parents I knew and myself, it was a non-stop round the clock work.

As mothers, we don't realise that as we start cutting back on attending prayer meetings, house groups and even during church service, we walk our toddlers outside the church hall so as not intending to disturb the others, we end up not listening to the message and sacrificing our much-needed spiritual food.

Sometimes we do not realise we are inching towards the starting point of spiritual dryness leading to our inner man becoming weaker and that's when the stresses, depression, anxiety and worries begin to become larger than they are. As we now see it from a different point in our lives where our spirit man is unintentionally lying low, our challenges seem too much to handle at times. They may appear as Goliath's in front of us.

There are times when your domestic helper is not up to the mark, or you don't have a helper at all, the family support seems insufficient, the child is falling prey to flu's, coughs and colds, and exploring everything around him with his hands and his mouth, increasing your work only a hundred times more.

Your refrigerator, car, oven all come with an operating manual. As parents, we have the best instruction book called the Bible and as we continue to make time to meditate on God's Word and serve in the ministry even in the smallest

way possible, God will honour your sacrifice and you will see blessings in your situation, your challenges and even your child/children will be easier to manage than you expect.

My son is now in his tweens and I remember when he was just a toddler, I was always worried and anxious about the smallest of things. My anxiousness would result in emotional outbursts as I wanted to be the perfect mom. I read my Bible less and less and made no effort to take out any time for the Lord's work. I was completely engrossed in going through the routines of each day. It was not until I started serving in a ministry that I witnessed the double-edged sword scripture. Not only was I helping in the ministry but that ministry began to help me instead

and speak into my own life. By reading testimonies of others, I began to feel encouraged. I had to read the Bible now as I was involved in writing and editing articles and hence had to refer to the Bible for scriptural back up resulting in an increase in my hunger for God's Word which was re-kindled. I started reading more and more of the Bible. The Bible is the Word of God and by reading the words uttered by God, I saw breakthrough in challenges around me. I sensed how big our God is and my situations and challenges started seeming smaller and smaller compared to the enormity of God's power. My situation was the same, my outlook had changed.

Let me share a recent testimony. I have a neighbour who had a disagreement clash of words with me and she had created through her son some disturbances during play time among the children downstairs at the play area. There was a coldness and very inappropriate behaviour exhibited by this neighbour's child towards my child. I was immensely grieved and terribly hurt. It was about the same time I gave my name for serving at church. I shared my challenge with the ministry givers from family life ministry at Grace assembly and they didn't give up on my situation but prayed for me and constantly encouraged me. I stood in prayer myself and proclaimed God's Word. I submitted my challenge to God and made it His problem instead of mine.

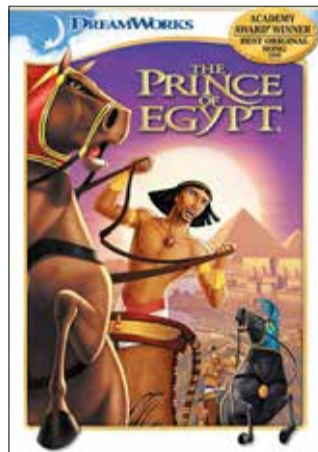
Miraculously, this neighbour's boy in just a short period of a few days and weeks completely turned around and he is now on his best behaviour towards us. He has become polite and friendly towards my child and their friendship is back to being of sound nature.

Making time was difficult but it was a step of faith. When we accept Christ, it is a step of faith in believing that Jesus died for you and you have eternal life and salvation through Him. Serving in church and ministry is another similar step of the same faith. I chose to serve in an area where the hours were flexible and I could work from home and what was required were timely co-ordinations and submission of write ups, articles and testimonies.

Remember when you serve in a ministry you are now in touch with spiritual leaders and they become your extended spiritual family and they are holding you in prayer even as you serve you are now on their list of intercession. You can call on your ministering team to encourage you, hold your needs in prayer.

Hang in there and trust the Lord that He watches over your precious child and as your child grows it is important you grow in faith and glory too. You are as precious as your child is and your child will look to your faith and testimony as he/she matures. Children are like recorders, they playback everything. In trying times when you child is older, he will surely look to God's Word for guidance in faith as he has grown up being a witness of your spiritual walk in Christ.

Stay connected to God's Word and the church and be encouraged to come forward and get involved even if a little step forward. I pray that all of us continue to receive His grace as both you and your toddler grow together in faith and glory.

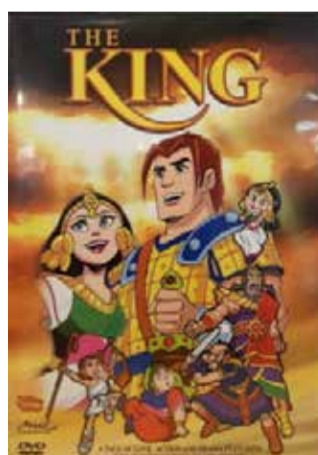
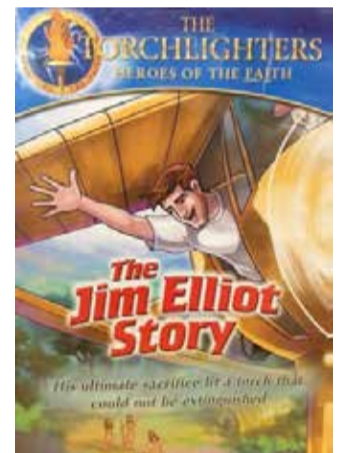

C.A.M. IN BANGLADESH

In the last couple years, the Creative Arts Ministry (CAM) has actively commissioned teams to the missions field to conduct training for local worship ministries. Our first trip for 2017 was to Dhaka and Faridpur, in Bangladesh from 19 – 25 June.

In all, 12 of us went on the trip. Yet, until the 11th hour, it was doubtful if there would be enough manpower. 2 months before the trip, only a few people had confirmed their availability, which would be especially difficult because instrument workshops cannot be conducted if there are no musicians. However, God proved He is in control when in the span of just over a week, God provided more than half the remaining trippers!

We kickstarted our trip with a 3-day Worship conference in the Dhaka. In attendance were 300 worship pastors and teams from all over Bangladesh, all eager to learn about worship and the ministry of worship. On top of the technical instrument and band workshops, we also covered topics such as — How to read the Bible, Prayer for Spiritual Breakthrough, Building Youth Leaders, and Building a Worship Team.

A unique challenge posed to all Worship Missions teams is ascertaining the skill levels of the musicians attending and adjusting our content accordingly. We saw a very big range of musicianship ranging from the consummate singer/musician, to the village church guitarist just learning how to play simple chords. Suffice to say, all the polished, technical lesson plans, went out the window, and all of us adapted and gave it our best shot.

Following the worship conference, we made our way to the town of Faridpur, where we would spend some time at a girl's orphanage and conduct ministry training, followed by adult and children's services at the local church. The perseverance and steadfastness of the local Christians, in the midst of difficult conditions and continuing persecution in the predominantly Muslim nation, was truly humbling, as many face threats or have been outcast from their families and communities.

Our last day was spent in the city of Uttara, at a children and youth service. It was a powerful time of ministry at the end of the service, with all the children so hungry to be prayed for, many falling under the power of the Holy Spirit.

Reflecting on some of our key prayers in preparation for our trip; we prayed to God for the following:

1. Whatever we do, we do out of love
2. Sensitivity to the Holy Spirit and His work
3. Our messages and lessons to be sharp
4. Ego and pride aside, and humility & servanthood to abound

We are always very aware that the worship team can very easily fall vulnerable to pride because of the very nature of being on stage week in and out. And we knew that if we let ego get in the way, that we would not accomplish anything for the kingdom of God.
