RESOUNDING PRAISE & REFLECTION

GMC is entering into the 2nd year since its launch in January 2016, with the 1st module, Christology, that had more than 30 students from Grace Assembly. The last module, Courageous Conflict Resolution, was held from 17 to 19 November 2016.



A total of 57, including 7 couples from Family Life Ministries, pastors and leaders from ICM; our partner, and churches, attended this module taught by Dr Joe Umidi. Most of us have benefited from his teaching, and learned from him the biblical approach and practical effective constructive resolution strategies, methods and managing conversations.

We are filled with gratefulness to God for the students who have signed up for the modules and continued to be faithful in attending the program.

REINTRODUCTION

Grace Missional College (GMC), inaugurated in 2016, is a joint-collaboration with Christian Life Educators Network (CLEN) and Oral Roberts University (ORU).

CLEN is a membership network of independent schools, instructors and students providing standardized Bible-based education to equip and empower students around the world for Christian education and ministry training.

ORU establishes the accredited program to complement the educational ministries of the local church for the equipping of saints for ministry.

GMC, in short, organized under the vision and direction of New GRACE, which encapsulates core values of the Missional Family Church into the curriculum to realize its desired strategy and outcomes through equipping individuals with the Word and practical ministry skills, to lead an intentional missional life and service in the church and community.

Two specialized and accredited programs, Christian Ministry and Christian Missions, for short-term Certificate and Diploma in Theological Studies.

Short-term Certificate is a 19-credit program (6 modules), including 1-hour practicum. Diploma of Theological Studies is a 33-credit program (10 modules), including 3-hour practicum.



WHOLENESS SEMINAR

So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord — who is the Spirit — makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.

2 Corinthians 3:18 NLT

If you are searching for God's touch in your life in the area of inner healing and are looking to hear from God's word what He says about your situation, we encourage you to read the following questions answered by **Pastor Benjamin** and **Sister Tricia** who will be leading us **along with their team** through the Wholeness Seminar in the different areas of inner healing this month in February.

Q1) How do I know that I need Inner Healing in my life?

This ministry is not just for the down and out or those who are emotionally unstable. We would like to debunk the myth that only those who are problematic need inner healing.

All of us are God's work in progress. God desires us to be transformed from glory to glory. That's the reason why we are here in our faith journey on this earth and not in heaven.

Whether you are a new believer, a mature believer, or a leader in

the church or someone struggling with addictions or bondages in your life, we all need this ministry.

In fact, receiving this ministry is like doing 'spring-cleaning' to our souls every now and then as we gather "dust" along the way in our growth journey. We want nothing to clog our spiritual pipes to God. We want to be able to hear God and sense God in our daily lives. God's will is that we walk in freedom and experience a greater intimacy with Him. So, Wholeness Ministry is for all who desire to grow deeper in our relationship with Him.

Q2) Is the Inner Healing Ministry similar to a Deliverance Ministry?

Wholeness ministry is much more than just deliverance from demonic oppression and healing of past hurts. We (Ministry Givers - MGs) deal with hidden ungodly beliefs by helping the participants (Ministry Receivers - MRs) to construct and replace these ungodly beliefs with godly ones from His Word. We also deal with past hurts by leading MRs to experience the healing of memories. Through the revelation of the Holy Spirit, we also deal with generational patterns by leading the MRs through identification repentance and cutting of ungodly soul ties. During the ministry sessions, there will also be times when the MRs hear from God and receive prophetic revelation pertaining to their lives and God's promises for them.

In using the Restoring the Foundation (RTF) integrated model, we also teach all MRs to continue to walk in freedom, and to use the tool to deal with their issues as they arise there and then.

It can also be used as a discipleship tool in having greater intimacy with Father God and transformed lives in Christ.

Q3) How would the three days of the workshop be organised?

There are 2 parts. In Part 1 of the seminar, we address the roots of our struggles from God's Word, receive the teachings, hear testimonies from previous participants, and release prophetic words to individuals during the altar ministry time. All these help build the faith of the MRs and cause them to be aware of the enemy's strategy in keeping us bound. By teaching God's truth, we expose the lies of the enemy and prepare the MRs to receive ministry in the ministry room, which is Part 2 of the seminar. The MGs will meet the MRs individually to take them through the ministry process in the three-hour session.

Q4) Would I have a chance to share my challenging situation that I am currently facing and receive prayer and counselling?

Yes. In fact, when you (MR) attend the Wholeness Seminar, you are given a Personal Questionnaire (also known as PQ) to fill up so that the MGs can better understand your struggles and challenges. During Part 2 of the ministry process, the MGs will use the questionnaire to do a quick interview to confirm the assessment and then spend the entire time praying through the issues with you.

Q5) What expectations must I have regarding my situation after attending this workshop?

God's work of sanctification is progressive in transforming us from glory to glory. Like an onion, the Holy Spirit is always gentle and patient and will deal with us layer by layer until we are perfect in Christ. He will not deal with us in the issues that we are not ready to allow Him to work on. The extent of our freedom is the extent of our openness to Him. Come with an open mind and heart for the Holy Spirit to work in our lives and you will see breakthroughs in your life!

Q6) Must I be a Christian in order to attend the workshop? Can I be a relative or friend of a Grace member?

Yes. You need to be a believer in order to fully benefit from the ministry. We wish we could extend the ministry to non-Gracians. This is a very 'labour-intensive' ministry and at this point, we only have a small ministry team. So we hope to give priority to Gracians.

Q7) Could you summarize your final thoughts for the Wholeness Seminar?

We have started Wholeness Ministry using the Restoring the Foundations (RTF) integrated approach for 2 years. We are excited in seeing lives set free and the testimonies that we have been receiving from the ministry team and participants have been simply awesome and encouraging. It's amazing to hear how God touches and transforms lives.

We know this is the season and time that God wants to do a deeper work in His children. Let's get the spiritual trash out and be transformed into His likeness.

Come and experience the Father's love and goodness.

REACH Bursary Awards 2017

REACH Bursary and Mentoring Programme is in its 9th year running and it has helped countless low-income families by relieving financial stress when it comes to school-related expenses.

REACH Bursary and Mentoring Programme is unique because the bursary awards are handed out to applicants based on potential instead of good academic results.

Most bursary awards are given to needy students who are doing well in studies while in the case of REACH, the bursary awards are given to needy students who are struggling in their studies.

The bursary award is given in two parts – once at the commencement of the Bursary and Mentoring Programme and once at their graduation from the programme. Recipients of the bursary award will have to go through the year-long mentoring programme before they can graduate and receive the second part of the award.

Mentors guide the recipients in their studies and positively influence their thoughts, speech and behaviour through sharing their life experiences and coaching.

This year, 113 recipients will receive a total of \$78,000. Through the generous donations and support from Grace Assembly of God and other donors, the youths are given the opportunity to improve holistically through the programmes in REACH.

THE SAFEST PLACE IN THE WORLD

By the time you are reading this article, I would already be in Istanbul, and I will be there for the next six months for a university exchange program. I will be using my time there to serve the refugees too!

Many would probably say this: "Istanbul ... isn't it very dangerous there now?"

Located at the crossroads of Europe and the Middle East, Istanbul is a hub for refugees and extremists. The eclectic city has been in the news very often recently, having suffered major attacks in the past few years. From the June bombings on its Atatürk Airport to the New Year's shooting in a Reina nightclub, scores have been killed and far more injured.



I was in Jordan on a summer trip when the news first broke of the horrific suicide bombings on the Atatürk Airport on June 28. Immediately, I asked the Lord, "Should I still head to Istanbul to study and serve the refugees there?"

There is a difference being confident in the will of God and being reckless. As long as God gives the green light, I have no qualms going ahead. We should not rush into compromising situations.

Soon after, I was in an overnight prayer meeting seeking direction from the Lord. A local went up and started quoting the Scripture. I hardly remembered anything he said, except that there was something about "a highway from Egypt to Assyria."

The next day, my friends and I brought an Iraqi friend out for dinner. When we were in the car, he started excitedly typing on his phone and quickly showed me what was on his screen. It was Isaiah 19:23 — "In that day there will be a highway from Egypt to Assyria. The Assyrians will go to Egypt and the Egyptians to Assyria. The Egyptians and Assyrians will worship together."

That was the exact same verse God highlighted to me the night before. I found out, to my amazement, that the Assyrians were people from Turkey and parts of Syria and Iraq.

It was a divine confirmation from the Lord that I was on the right track, and I could proceed with heading over to learn and serve the people He loves so much.

There is a famous saying that goes, "The safest place in the world is to be in the center of God's will." While doing the will of God certainly may not lead us to the safest places, we can be rest assured that it is the best place to be in.

STARTING OUT IN TANJONG PINANG

Considering the language barrier and cultural differences, I started the missions trip with a little doubt and skepticism. So it was ironic that our journey to Tanjong Pinang started on a boat, which reminded me of some of the greatest Bible stories about faith and obedience. Without having to walk on water or be swallowed by a big fish, I saw how when we trust and obey, God always amazes us.

During the Saturday Christmas service for the kids, Xin, Channy, Joo Ee and Myung Duk put together a puppet show and short message about the true meaning of Christmas and the cleansing power of Jesus' blood. It was so encouraging to see almost all the children raising their hands in rededication to follow Jesus. For me, looking at how intensely the kids clasped their hands and bowed in prayer was truly humbling and a great reminder of the childlike faith we ought to have. Speaking of childlike faith, it was such a blessing to see our youngest mission tripper, 4.5 year old Eli (eldest son of Alex and Channy), giving out Christmas presents to the local kids.



In the adult service, Alex shared his personal and impactful story about his family background and how God used his broken family's past to create the loving and Godly family that he now has with his wife Channy and their three kids. For the local people who faced many marriage and family issues, Alex's sharing must have felt like a healing balm on a hurting wound. The team ended the night by blessing the local people with an Indonesian worship song called Kar'na SalibMu, which means Because Of Your Cross. The song spoke about how only Jesus can purify, restore and is our hope and everything.

During the Sunday service, Kok Lin and I teamed up to share a message about "The Joy in and Beyond Christmas". Kok Lin started by talking about the joy of the Lord and aptly used Apostle Paul's story in prison. He delivered some timely reminders about how we can rejoice no matter what we are going through in life. I took over the baton by sharing some personal stories to talk about prayer, thanksgiving and the peace of God. Concurrently downstairs, Joo Ee and Alex were using simple illustrations to teach the local children about the fruits of the Spirit.

The local food was delicious and the team ate like it was the last supper. After lunch, the local pastor and his wife invited us to visit the plot of land which God had blessed them with for their new church building. After that, we visited the pastor's home to hear about their specific church / community needs that the next team could address in 2017. We then prayed for their family needs and ministry desires for the coming year.

We would like to thank Ps Peck Yin for leading us on this trip. Her shepherd's heart touched us deeply and reminded us how God can do mighty things when we avail ourselves. We are glad to have had the privilege to bring our five loaves and two fish, and witnessed how God multiplied





it to sow seeds into the lives of the people of Tanjong Pinang. To God be the glory!

THE HEALING POWER OF JESUS IN INDIA

I was part of a team of 13 people led by Ps Matthew Tan. We were in Odisha, India from 09 - 18 December 2016. We ran Children's programs, shared in believer's meetings (cell groups) and did healing services.

In this particular trip, one area that impacted me the most was when we visited the homes of the Hindus in the villages at Jajpur. They were warm, hospitable and almost all the families served us with sweet drinks. Prior to this trip, I have been to three missions trips and I usually did children programs for the churches and when there were house visitations, we visited only the homes of the believers', never the non-believers.

It began when we went to the villages to do healing and deliverance for two days. After we conducted our first healing service, news of healing started to spread. The village pastor then requested for us to visit all the believers' homes to pray and bless the people. When the Hindus saw that the team was going around the homes of the Christians and healing happened, they also wanted such blessing. The Hindus who were usually against Christians called us into their homes. They were surrounded by idols and temples, we prayed for the sick and delivered those possessed by demons. Healing happened everywhere we went — bodies were strengthened, deaf ears opened, the paralyzed started to walk again. We visited 35 families over two days.

On the last day we did a healing service at the church and many people turned up. The church hall was full and yet more people were still wanting to come in. They were sitting on rooftops, and some were sitting outside under the sun listening in through the windows. When Ps Matthew asked for testimonies, it was the Hindus who came up to testify of their healing.

God is indeed amazing to open doors for us in this manner. It does not matter what their religion is, or what they hang on their bodies. Jesus wanted to tell them that He loves them, and He did it through big displays of healing. I am sure that it pains the heart of God to see so many of them worshiping idols and living in poverty. Many souls have yet to know Jesus as

their savior, and God is actively reaching out to them.

It is heartening to see the Church in India working hard to care for the people and reaching out to the lost. We pray for many more souls to be saved, and people to continue seeking God and His righteousness. May the land of India be blessed!


