For a fresh new start in 2018, join us to read through the Bible and build ourselves in His Word and in our devotional lives.

We would like to encourage Gracians to adopt a two-year Bible reading plan together as a church.

This plan is adapted from https://timchester.wordpress.com/2016/12/11/bible-reading-plan-2017/ and has a number of differences from other plans.

BIBLE READING FOR 2018

- 1. **FLEXIBILITY** We can read a number of chapters for each week rather than for each day. We can read a chapter or two each day or in two or three sittings. Or we can read a chapter a day and then catch up at the weekend. It means it fits more readily around our lifestyle.
- 2. **COMMUNAL** Find a buddy or your family or your Grace Missional Family Group to journey through the Bible with. The plan makes it easy to discuss what we have been reading when we meet up with others. It's easy for us to discuss what we've been reading because there is only one Bible book to focus on each time. We only need look at the Bible plan once a week and need not to refer to it each day.
- 3. **REALISTIC** Following this plan, we read the OT once and the NT twice in two years. This works out at about 12-15 chapters a week. It means we are not rushing through what we are reading to 'get it done'. This plan gives us time to meditate and reflect on the passage.
- 4. **BALANCED** The plan balances the various styles of OT history, prophecy, wisdom, Gospel and Epistles throughout the year. We move between genres so we're never faced with reading one type of writing like OT prophecy continuously for six months.

We recommend using the **New Living Translation**. If you don't have this, you may want to read the New International Version. If you're doing family devotions with your children (aged 12 and below), a suitable one to read together with the family is the New International Readers' Version. For youths, the New Living Translation is excellent.

For those who prefer using your tablets and smartphones, do download the Reading Plan app. Select the plan **Edge 2 Year** and let the app help you keep track of your Bible reading.

Each week, there will also be a devotional entry put up in our Grace app and Grace website. These Scriptural reflections may also come from the Bible portions of our reading plan.

Blessed Bible Reading! May we grow deeper in His Word!

UPCOMPING 1ST TERM 2018 MODULES

BICC176: FOUNDATION OF CHRISTIAN COUNSELING

15-17 March 2018

Professor: Dr Irvin Rutherford

This course examines three aspects of counseling within the Christian context: (1) a theological foundation for Christian counseling, (2) communication and relationship building skills necessary for being an effective helper, and (3) helping theories and their application for the Christian counselor or for a ministry of people-helping in the context of a Christian community.

BIBT325: PNEUMATOLOGY (THE STUDY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT)

10-12 May 2018

Professor: Dr Jerry Horner

This course examines the Biblical teaching on the Holy Spirit, the third person of the Trinity. Emphasis is placed on the personality and deity of the Holy Spirit, His work in regeneration, sanctification, Spirit baptism and Christian service.



Depending on individual issues, 1-3 ministry sessions would be set aside per person scheduled after the seminar.



empower our children to be selfcontrolled people living freely under the authority of God.


The central focus of parenting is the gospel, and our children need to understand not only "what" they did wrong but also the internal "why" they did it.





GOD LOVES HIS PEOPLE BY CHIN SOO FUN

Women's Conference Myitkyina, Myanmar

When Myitkyina was first described to me, I imagined it to be a scenic, rustic and tranquil place. My heart longed to see its beauty and to serve God's people there, but the calling didn't come until three years later. Although it came most unexpectedly, God knew my heart was ready and willing despite my rational mind reminding me about my heavy work load and the urgent material preparation on the topic of emotionally healthy spirituality.

As there is no hotel in Waimaw where the three-day conference was held, our team of four needed to commute by car from Myitkyina for about 30 minutes each way every day. The daily commute took us through the quaint city centre of Myitkyina, across the placid Irrawady River and then over to the lush countryside of Waimaw. It was indeed a picture of charming rustic tranquility.

We were grateful to God for giving us the wisdom and knowledge to adjust our teaching to better cater to the needs of the women from the surrounding farming communities with a small number from the internally displaced refugee camps. The attendance averaged about 250 a day. Some traveled long distance to attend the conference, leaving behind children and pressing chores at home. A few even came with infants in tow. Some spoke only tribal languages and therefore did not understand the translation in Burmese. Nevertheless, they persevered and were

ministered by the small group leaders in the afternoon sessions. On the second day, some stayed back for the evening session on the topic of marriage and family. Such dedication and devotion to God definitely touched us who are accustomed to convenience and comfort. We experienced the powerful anointing of God as we shared his word using examples and testimonies that the women could relate to. Where our natural ability and knowledge fumbled, God's anointing took over and put in our mouths the words He wanted his beloved people to hear.

On the final day of the conference when three altar calls were made, I held my breath initially when I heard the sounds of only a few shuffling feet. Then the sounds became stronger and stronger and eventually the altar area was not big enough to accommodate everyone. The pews had to be moved backward not once but several times. I was overcome by God's great love for His people. God revealed to me his heart for the people and I counted myself privileged to be his instrument. We had prayed that the Holy Spirit would move mightily among his people and he was faithful to the end. The testimony time just before closing had more eager women who wanted to testify than there was time for everyone.

When God calls us to do his work, he will enable and empower us. We need only to obey and trust him. I was awed by his love for the people.

The Tanjung Pinang church was small. The women's ministry meeting started with just 6 women yet all of them sang with such fervour their voices of praise filled the room as if it was a concert hall. We were greatly encouraged by their expression of worship.

We shared our testimonies in the women's, youth and adult ministries. For the first time, we opened ourselves and poured out our hearts to share our lives and inner struggles to complete strangers, giving glory to God for His grace and power in transforming our lives and encouraging others who were struggling with similar issues to draw close to God.

Half way through the Youth service, a girl came and sat at the back. At the closing prayer, we noticed the girl was yet to be prayed for. Even after prayer, she appeared very much burdened. After a private talk, she released her story of brokenness and fear. We cried, comforted, encouraged and prayed with her. On Sunday, God deposited His Word into her heart through our sharing and testimony. She responded to the altar call and came again for the family seminar. There we noticed brightness in her face. Oh how lovely was her countenance. It must be God who touched her by His Spirit of love.

Some went to her to give her Scripture verses and affirming words (Malachi 4:2, Psalm 139:3). We passed a purple shawl to her, claiming that she shall wear a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair (Isaiah 61:3). God has started a healing work in her and in time to come she will bloom for His Glory.

Although everyone is unique with vastly different backgrounds, a common thread runs through us regardless of nationality, age, gender, circumstances and social status - we are empty and broken without God. Only God can fill this hole in our hearts, heal our broken spirit,

transform our lives and give us a sense of identity. Indeed, we are fearfully and wonderfully made children in the image of God. Our stories and struggles caused us painful and ugly wounds but God can heal and use these to make something beautiful in His time - powerful testimonials to glorify God and encourage others.





When the registration closed, we were met with an incredible figure of 101 pre-believers and 57 Gracians sign up. We have to turn down a few due to insufficient helpers and limitation of facility.

On the first day of the camp, about 40 children indicated they wanted Jesus to be their personal Lord and Saviour. Praise God for His work!

In conclusion, I believe this camp is just the beginning of many outreach activities to the community children. I sincerely urge Gracians to stretch out your helping hands for future outreach activities.




