FAITH-FILLED MOMENTS IN GRACE RETREAT 2018

When we knew we could secure Sunway Pyramid Hotel for our retreat, the idea of having pre-believing relatives started germinating. Sunway is one of the few venues that could accommodate 1000 persons, afford 5 halls for services and allow a common dining area. The church leadership came alongside us and agreed to provide a subsidy for these pre-believing relatives.

We had a total of 15 guests who attended Alpha, Children's & Youth programs @ Grace Retreat 2018. There were 10 pre-believers or whose faith were undetermined, and 5 salvations and/or rededications. On the third night, Alpha had the lesson on the Baptism in the Holy Spirit, 4 were slain and at least 2 spoke in tongues for the first time. Everyone was also extremely encouraged by the healings that took place, from trigger and sprained finger, numbness in hand, different arm lengths, stiff shoulders to pain in the eye. PTL!

The second faith-filled moment was the registration. On week 4 of our registration, we only had 100 rooms taken, or less than 300 persons registered. On the same week, we had to account to the hotel the number of rooms to wash down without incurring a penalty. The committee was nervous and worried for sure. There were manydifferent reasons we heard, eg. no early bird no hurry, afraid of the accent of a British speaker, etc. So many told us to extend the deadline. But we mobilised the intercessors and chose to pray furiously. Amazingly, within 2 weeks, the number increased exponentially, the final figure was 870 registered. We are ever so thankful that we did not need to extend our registration and we managed to collect all the payments within the stipulated time. Though we had some heart-attack-like moments, we are thankful that Gracians had been really kind to us.

The third faith-filled moment was God's provision. In order to keep the price of the retreat affordable, we had to omit some lunches. However, for safety and programming purposes, the Youth Program had to fill the other two afternoons, which means 2 more lunches had to be provided, which means they had to pay more for the retreat then the adults. But God is Jehovah Jireh, He provided. We had generous sponsors who were more than willing to sponsor the lunches and other sponsors who paid for the community kids and any needs we had. We are truly awed by God's provision.

With that, I just want to say we serve a faithful God! We thank Him for this journey of faith! We are thankful for the opportunity to serve Him!

The walk of faith is a challenging one!

The recent Grace Retreat 2018 reassured me that I am not alone in feeling emotionally weak or physically tired. There will be days when my entire outlook of life is gloom and doom. I might have many questions in my convoluted mind like "Why me, Lord?". Looking across the room with a troubled heart, heavy feet and eyelids at a Bible resting on the table, the decision on whether to drag myself over and still seek God's face will be a simple test of my faith.

Our guest speaker, Pastor Dr. John Andrews introduced 6 main characters in this retreat, under the theme "Faith. Faithful. Faith-filled." Each day we delved into 2 characters - Mary, Joshua, Jacob, David, Joseph and Paul. There is something to learn from each of them but I shall focus on Mary as I am encouraged by her stretch of faith to accept something she could not have understood.

In Luke 1:26-38, angel Gabriel appeared to Mary, telling her that she would conceive and give birth to a son. Even though the message was from an angel, in Mary's logical mind, she questioned Gabriel how a miraculous conception could have taken place since she was, in fact, a virgin. Given the Jewish culture, Mary was likely in a predicament on how she was going to break the news to Joseph. By the end of the conversation with Gabriel, she submitted to God's will, although she was terrified and uncomfortable.

Often I face dilemmas similar to Mary. My time on Earth will be filled with unknowns and uncertainties. Many things I may not comprehend but I can choose to make a conscious decision to say "Yes, this will be new to me but I will step out." Hence, the leap of faith begins.

A turning point in my life took a decade. I was born into a Christian family but I was a teenager who had enough and wanted to explore the world. Before I knew it, I had drifted further and further away from God's kingdom. While I was away, I was aware in my heart that sooner or later, I will need to return to Him, not sure where, when or how but one day. From time to time, He would show Himself in unexpected situations and through people, to tell me He still cares and will forever be waiting for me to come home, that whatever it may be, it is okay as His son, Jesus, has finished the work on the cross.

It is my humble prayer that we will praise God and trust Him even when we cannot see the end. Time will flash by but I pray that God does not pass us by. Life is fragile. May I then challenge you to constantly think about whether you and I have that kind of faith Mary has?

Zoe's Testimony

Why my family and I left New Zealand for good...

My family and I lived in New Zealand for more than 10 years before we decided to move back to Asia. I always believe everything happened for a reason. And in my case, it was for many reasons. God saw the bigger picture and He planned for every single details to bring me to where I am today.

In December 2010, on that fateful late afternoon at 5pm, as I was preparing to leave my office to go home, my life was forever changed. As I was walking to get my car parked on the side of the road, I saw from the corner of my eyes a car was turning into the car park. In a split of a second, I found myself smashed into the glass window of an aquarium shop. The next thing I knew I saw in despair my right leg broken and twisted 180 degrees. I screamed in agony of the pain I was having.

A shop lady came to my rescue and held on to me tightly as I couldn't move and I felt glass pieces piercing my back. She said, "You will be okay. Stay still." I was in tears and I cried, "I am in so much pain! I'm pregnant! God please help me!" I noticed shards of broken glasses embedded into my left thigh and on my stomach. I thank God I was wearing a thicker jacket that day otherwise I was pretty sure, there would be more on my body as well.

I remembered singing "Jesus Loves Me" in my head trying to comfort myself and trying hard not to focus on the pain and the dire situation I was in. I was later told I suffered from a complete fracture of my right tibia and fibula. Seeing the state of my broken right leg I thought I would never be able to walk again.

I was rushed to the hospital in an ambulance and I was hospitalised for 10 days after the operation and more complications followed due to the accident and I had to be readmitted to the hospital for kidney infection two weeks later. The whole ordeal took a toll on me physically, mentally and emotionally. I felt bad that I couldn't look after my twins. I was in a cast and using the crutches to walk. I was feeling rather depressed and I didn't want to see any of my friends at all. My doctor saw the state I was in and advised that we should go back home to Asia for a nice holiday to be reunited with my family even if it was for a short time. I listened to her advice and we flew home to celebrate CNY. The holiday was good for my soul as I was happier seeing my family and friends back home. However what happened next was entirely unplanned but I think God knew what it would take for us to move back home.

On the 22nd February 2011, Christchurch had a massive earthquake which destroyed most of the city and it hit close to home as I lost my favourite boss Murray Wood whom I used to work for for a couple of years. The CTV office building he was working in collapsed and he was one of the many victims. The Christchurch earthquake coupled with my accident traumatised me and I was not in the right state of mind to go back to Christchurch. I was worried about the earthquake, my kids (we didn't have any family in NZ to help us out) and I was still using crutches. I told my husband, Justin that I didn't want to go back and I wanted to stay in Singapore. It was a tough decision for us as we have built quite a comfortable life in New Zealand. My loving and supportive husband agreed and he went back on his own to pack up everything, our house, our car, so that we could move to Singapore. I knew it was not an easy decision for my husband as he has been a dentist for over 10 years in New Zealand. He had to give up the patient base he had built over the years. It was hard for him to uproot and start over but he did it anyway because he loves me and the kids. I thank God for providing me with a loving, supportive and understanding husband who would put God and his family first. Who would have thought, that our short holiday in Singapore would become a permanent stay for us. Fast forward to today, we are now a happy family with 4 kids and Singapore is our home now. We are blessed to have found Grace Assembly of God to be our spiritual home and the warmth and hospitality shown by everyone in Grace family really helped us settle down here after having lived overseas for most of our lives.



I am thankful to God, my Jesus, my Savior that I am alive to retell the story. And so did my miracle baby, Callum. I feel like every day after the accident is a bonus for me and the way I look at life has changed tremendously. We never know when God wants us to return to Him and that's why it's so important to cherish our moments with our loved ones and to always live our life purposefully. I am glad I found my purpose in my life too, not just as a child of God, a daughter, a sister, a wife, a mother but also as a baby and child sleep expert touching and transforming the lives of many young families with kids who are tired and sleep deprived.

Blessed are those who persevere under the trial, because when they have stood the test, they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love Him.

Zoe's Calling

How God lead me to become a baby and child sleep expert

I was 26 when I had my twins in New Zealand and like most first time parents, I had not known what to expect. From the minute I brought them home from the hospital, I knew I needed some serious help. In the space of a few moments my world turned upside down and I was no longer just Zoe. I became a mother who was responsible for the two little angels that gazed up at me as if I were their whole world.

Like most expectant moms, I had been completely focused on my pregnancy. I read many books on my developing babies, how they were growing, the different stages of pregnancy, and even the kind of exercises I should be doing to get ready for labour. It never once (not once) occurred to me, to read books on what to do once my babies were here. Well sure, I did read about how to care for my babies, how to feed them, burp them and even change them, but I really wished someone had told me when I was pregnant, how to settle a baby to sleep.

As it is for every parent, so it was for me, except that I was even more tired than most because my twins were double trouble!

I struggled to get both of my twins to sleep for the first couple of months. I remember having many sleepless nights as one twin woke up, needing to be fed, and then the other woke up an hour later, crying for his milk too. I felt like a zombie. Sleep was so precious to me and it felt like days

or weeks since I had slept at all. It was getting to the point that I couldn't concentrate on anything; my twins were controlling the sleeping pattern of everyone in my house.

That was all about to change one fine day.

My journey of sleep training began when a friendly neighbour of mine, Vania (who has two kids herself), noticed my struggles and probably my tired eyes. She told me to read some sleep training books, to help bring order to my babies' day. To be honest, I wasn't even sure what the term sleep training meant but I wanted to find out!

I finally had a plan and within weeks I had started pouring myself into countless sleep training books, to try and figure out how to get my twins to fall asleep on their own, stay asleep and sleep through the night. All the sleep issues I was having with my twins, night waking, short naps and routine issues were doubled!

I must admit, it was rough for the first few months, but once I figured it all out, it was a huge turning point for my sanity and my whole family's wellbeing. A lot of my friends were amazed and started asking me for advice on how to settle their babies and get them to sleep throughout the night.

A few years later, along came my third and fourth baby and by this time I had developed a sixth sense for what babies and young children need to learn to sleep well and through the night. I started out being known as

the sleep training guru among my friends and families. So, I turned my passion into my mission to helping many sleep deprived families get back their well-deserved rest.

Zoe Chu is a renowned Sleep Supernanny, a baby and child sleep expert and parenting speaker based in Singapore. Zoe is often invited to speak to parents in schools, hospitals, corporations and parent groups and her presentations are always well received.

Her work has been featured in many media outlets and she is frequently quoted as a baby and child sleep expert in newspapers, magazines, online news media such as Mother & Baby, Singapore Motherhood, Sunday Times, Expat Living, Lianhe Zaobao, Asiaone, Smartparents and Channel Newsasia.

Zoe is a mother of four including a set of twins. THE PRAYER OF A DESPERATE PARENT SERIES

THE DAUGHTER EVERY MOTHER SHOULD HAVE.

Like summer snow, Sarah Rudd Chia came to us. Unexpected and joyful.

Two years after my son, Daniel was born, my husband Colin and I decided to try for a second child. I was an Associate Creative Director at a multinational advertising agency. The job required late nights and extensive travel. As work picked up pace, I suggested to Colin, let's wait a little longer since we already have a child.

A couple of weeks later, I started feeling nauseous. I thought it was the stress of work. Only when a colleague pointed it out, did I think of doing a pregnancy test. Lo and behold, it was positive. I was stumped. Tears of gratitude filled my eyes. God had been generous with me.

Unlike my previous pregnancy where I had glowing skin, this one gave me acne for the first time in my life. Despite needing hormone jabs through the first trimester to support my pregnancy, I was in high spirits.

Colin had a dream of a little girl with angel wings in place of her ears, while I was carrying her. So we knew we were going to have a daughter with ears that would be sensitive to sound of heaven. God told him she was to be called Sarah. Despite having gestational diabetes during this pregnancy, forcing me to cut down carbs and sugar, I felt the hand of God upon me.

Sarah was supposed to be a Christmas baby. But I prayed she'd be born a few days earlier so I didn't have to celebrate Christmas in the hospital. At 4.30am on Dec 22, 2010, I went into labour.

When we arrived at the hospital, I was so excited. I can't explain the joy I felt. The nurse greeted me and declared I was the happiest and calmest mom-to-be she's ever seen, as I laughed and joked with her despite the pain.

Where Daniel's birth had been a challenge, Sarah's was smooth. My epidural worked. I discussed my special Apple Strudel recipe with my gynaecologist in-between pushes.

Sarah came out effortlessly and quickly. There were minimal stitches. She was ruddy with a head full of black hair. She gave out a loud wail. The second she saw me, she stopped and smiled - like sunlight peering through dark clouds.

Breastfeeding her was a challenge. While Daniel was ravenous, Sarah fell asleep the second she smelt milk. And when the post natal blues kicked in harder and faster than my first pregnancy, I wondered why I had done this a second time! But having gone through it with Daniel, I was confident God would pull me through this one too.

Sarah's birth was a testament to God's abundance - that He's El Shaddai, more than enough. We stood on His promise for one child. He blessed us with two - a boy on my birthday and a girl during Christmas. I prayed desperately when I had Daniel. But with Sarah, I lifted my hands in praise and sang heartily.

With Daniel, I planned to spend quality time with the family and cut back on work. With Sarah, I felt God birthed a strong spirit of destiny and victory inside me. It made me brave. I fought for my seat at the table at work. I stood up for what I believed was right no matter what it cost me. I spoke up for the underdogs and vehemently enforced justice.

Now we had two children who were recording our every actions and words like CCTVs. I often took them to the office so they wouldn't miss me during the weekends. They watched me present work and hold my own in front of my bosses. They watched me voice my opinions and express my creativity without excuse as I led and mentored my creative team.

Each time I was pressured to compromise, the Holy Spirit reminded me that I was an example to my children. When I encountered sexual harassment or jokes with sexual connotation, I would address it because I know I am instrumental in changing a culture that my daughter could one day be subjected to.

Over the years, I have made a conscious effort to be an example to my daughter in the way I dress and the way I carry myself. I want Sarah to know, a woman of God can be anything and everything she wants to be by His grace - that she shouldn't be paid less or held back from important roles because of her gender. I want her to do amazing things for Jesus and be whatever God has called her to be. After all, the Proverbs 31 woman was an industrious working mum with an entrepreneurial spirit.

Most importantly, my husband and I decided our children shouldn't be an excuse when it came to serving God. We both serve actively in the worship ministry in church. *Joshua 24:15 says, "...As for me and my family, we'll serve the Lord."* In fact, our kids are a key reason why we serve God. Through our service and commitment, we want them to be planted in the house of God, to grow up loving and serving Him. In everything we do, we want our children to see that Jesus is the heartbeat of our family.


Can you recall a time that you were underdressed for an occasion? I certainly can. Some of those occasions happened during my National Service time and when I attended functions.



For the betterment of her family, she left home, stepped into the plane and consented to the hardships of the unknown. She worked hard with hope that every cent earned and remitted secures her kids' future.

As part of the post-service celebration, the congregation gathered at the fellowship area and bonded over food and games. A photo booth was set up for families and friends to take snapshots of the occasion.



45-year-old Go Boon Chai had a tougher childhood than most. Raised alongside his brother single-handedly by his mother, he rarely saw his father who lived in and ran Geylang's gambling dens. The full-time gambler would come home only "once or twice a week" before finally walking out on the family when Go turned twelve.

"I hated him," said Go. "How could someone be this irresponsible to abandon his kids without ever coming back? I would never follow in his footsteps.

To make ends meet, his lowly-educated mother worked multiple odd jobs while Go was forced to "grow up early" After school, the preteen sold prawn noodles in Redhill every day before working as a caddie boy in Sentosa while his peers were having playtime.

Decades later, a frustrated Go was running a struggling business and was often hostile towards his mother and brother. Desperate to clear off his debts, the then 38-year-old became involved in a study loan scam that cheated a few banks of over \$2.5 million and was sentenced to five years in jail.


Prison was a terrifyingly unknown place to the then-Buddhist Go. His childhood hope of providing his mother with "a better life" was utterly dashed as well. He recounted, "I was fearful. And of course, my family members were sad but there was nothing they could do."

However, it was in jail where Go met several Christian inmates who were unusually "sincere and caring". They introduced him to counselling services, chapel sessions and most importantly - the concept of an 'almighty God'.

In 2012, Go was confronted once again by his lifelong hatred for his father when an Easter sermon's message about forgiveness stirred up memories from his past.

"My (hatred) for my father was consuming me from the inside out and forgiveness was the only way to release me from my own anger", he said. "I repented and asked God then: 'Give me the strength to forgive and help me put my faith into action."

Powerless, he accepted Christ at the altar call and his prayer was soon fulfilled. Bitterness was replaced by gratefulness and His new-found faith grew as he discovered more about his saviour through the Bible. Go experienced His grace again when his good conduct earned him a 12-month earlier release.





Today, He is working in digital marketing and makes it his mission to write encouragement letters and festive cards monthly to his inmate peers who have relapsed into drug addiction shortly after being released. Yet despite their irregular replies, he persistently asks them about life in prison and prays for their well-being.

"No matter how tired I am from work, I will write out of my love for them without expecting anything in return. They have no freedom, so simple letters and visits mean a lot to them."

"These inmates are God's people too and need hope because they feel rejected from society - even more so when they are labelled as exconvicts and they are the least favored among job applicants.

For ex-convicts to experience God's grace and love, Go hopes that Gracians can truly understand their needs and readily contribute in securing them with steady jobs and food.

"Hold their hand until they are in a cell group because this isn't a hi-bye thing - we must be intentional in helping them while humbly seeing them as our equal.'

Ex-offenders or not, everyone is guilty of sin but worthy of forgiveness. Go believes that in a Godless world which sees ex-convicts as a liability, we need to create a Godly community that is inclusive, genuine and accepting - for there is now no condemnation for those who are in Jesus Christ (Romans 8:1).



MISSIONS CORNER BOOK REVIEW



'The Book That Transforms Nations' by Loren Cunningham

Missionary statesman Loren Cunningham shows us through the book how the destinies of nations across the world have been redirected when the yeast of God's Word was kneaded into the souls of their societies. Narrating in his direct and simple style, he persuades readers that the power of God's Word can turn impossible situations around. There are example after example of nations across the globe, from Switzerland to South Korea, where believers were relentless in applying biblical principles, such as fairness and equality, thereby bringing about amazing transformations.

To Cunningham, the answer to poverty, crimes, wars and spiritual darkness lies within the pages of Bible. The tipping point comes when a critical mass of the population seek to be guided by biblical principles. Even as he demonstrates that there is power in applying God's Word, he reiterates that we should be directed by the Holy Spirit to avoid the mistakes of the Pharisees and the Puritans; that we should seek the Author of the Book instead of the content.

Hence the call to action to believers is to bring the message of hope to nations. This hope is not just eternal salvation but a hope of a transformed society enlightened by biblical principles.

THE MESSAGE OF DISCIPLESHIP IN MISSIONS

"A family that serves together sticks together." On this trip 3 families across 3 generations came together to serve the church in Tanjung Pinang. The age gap between us was huge (9 to 77) but we enjoyed one another's presence and worked well together as a body of Christ! Especially encouraging was the 2 grandmothers on the team, who were great models of faith to the children.

We visited 3 churches, 2 of which were visited by teams from Grace Missions for the first time. It was sad to see how few the number of men who attended the church services was. The women's ministry allowed us to minster to the women through encouraging them to be strong and courageous (Joshua 1:9). As we shared and testified about having faith in God, they were also able to share their heartfelt prayer requests for their husbands to turn back to God. We prayed for them and all were touched by the love of Christ.

It has been on the heart of the local pastor that growth will happen among the churches and that the people would look beyond themselves. We preached on the importance of family discipleship in line with the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20). The congregations were challenged to be role models of faith to the younger ones, especially their own children, such as through having family devotions weekly. We pray for more families to grow together in faith!





We ended our trip with a seminar on the theme of exercising faith in the storm, ran separately for adults and youths. The adults were inspired by the life story of a brother on our team who overcame extreme challenges through faith in God. Many responded by placing their palms over their hearts as a commitment to live a life of faith. Over at the youth program, it was generally noisy with many distractions and technical errors. To see them losing focus was initially discouraging. Things did not go as planned. Yet God moved in ways we did not expect. Even through the games and skit, God was speaking into their lives. Towards the end, some were even nodding their heads and saying "Amen" in agreement. We might not have seen much fruit then, but we rejoice with the few who responded to have faith.

While there were times that we stumbled in running the programs, when we surrender all to Jesus, God will work in mighty ways. All glory to God! Let us continue to pray for disciples to be raised up from Tanjung Pinang, and for the young to have a strong ownership of their faith in Jesus Christ.

Very often, people ask or wonder "what are the basic biblical principles for Christian giving?" Starting March 2018 and over the next 10 issues of Grace Bulletin, we will provide the 10 essential truths about Christian giving, one for each issue of Grace Bulletin. We hope these truths or principles will provide answers to that question as we contemplate our own giving to the Lord's church in response to the clear teaching of His word.

26 Sep

Essential truth No 5. The Bible teaches that Christian giving is an act of worship. In connection with the previous point, we see this truth stressed in another way in Paul's word's "On the first day of every week each one of you is to put aside and save" (1 Corinthians 16:2). Paul here teaches the Corinthians that their taking up of the collection is an act of worship which is to be a part of their regular Lord's Day worship. When we put our money in the plate, we are worshiping Almighty God in accordance with His Word. Note well, Paul is speaking here of a "collection for the saints" - this is giving by the Church to the Church for the Church.

Did you realize that giving is a part of worship? Is your worship in this area abundant or inhibited? Is giving to the Church a priority with you?




