Summary of Chapter	In chapter 7, the Lord gave instructions to Moses to command the Israelites to present their offerings to the Lord in the wilderness of Sinai. In His instructions, the Lord made sure that the priests received their share of the offerings too.		

Key Verse(s) NLT	How does it speak to me?
35 This is their rightful share. The special gifts presented to the LORD have been reserved for Aaron and his descendants from the time they were set apart to serve the LORD as priests.	<p>In this verse, we see that Aaron and his sons were given a portion of all the sacrifices of the children of Israel for their ministry to the Lord as priests. God took good care of the priests who served him in the temple and provided for their needs. Similarly, He provides for all who serve him today especially those who serve Him full-time.</p> <p>I started full time ministry in Grace Assembly in 2001 without much savings. But the Lord was good. He blessed me all these years that I served him full time. I never had to worry about money. APPLICATION REFLECTIONS
