Scripture:	Genesis 17	Title:	Walking with the God I am knowing

Summary of Chapter:	This chapter is about the establishment of an everlasting covenant between God and Abraham and his descendants. The covenant is a promised relationship—He will be their God, and they will be His people. God is their El-Shaddai and they are to walk closely with Him.		

Key Verses (NLT):	How does it speak to me?
^{1b} I am El-Shaddai—‘God Almighty.’ Serve me faithfully and live a blameless life.	God is Almighty. He is sufficient for me. All I need to do is walk with Him faithfully. Because I know God has been faithful to me all these years, He will not fail me this time despite COVID-19. Just at the time when my new business venture was threatened by the pandemic, I set in my heart to claim on His promises. Even today, the Lord reminds me He is El-Shaddai, He is enough for me! Life’s storms might drown us in fear! But faith in God will grant us strength and hope. Is it possible to live blamelessly? Only if we have a relationship with God—it is not by works, but by knowing and trusting His character! May your doubts disappear, and may you live knowing God’s character. No matter what you are going through right now, He is more than enough for you! He had overcome; He will not leave you or forsake you.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

Adult:	Are there any worries and/or doubts preventing you from believing that God is sufficient for you? How will you claim this promise over that situation?
Youth:	How much do you believe that God is sufficient for you? Is there an area of your life you need to confess to God for your lack of understanding of Him?
Child:	What is one thing you know about God? Use an adjective to describe Him. How will this knowledge of God help you? eg. God is forgiving. When I make a mistake, I know He will forgive me.
