Focus Points:	Worship is a response that comes from the inner posture of our hearts. True worship is an offering of our whole lives as a living sacrifice.		
Key Verse(s) (NLT):	<i>And so the Lord says, “These people say they are mine. They honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. And their worship of me is nothing but man-made rules learned by rote.”</i>		
Devotional	Worship is not what we do for God, because He is all sufficient and He does not need our worship. However, God wants His children to approach Him with a right posture of our hearts. Because of who He is and what He has done for us, worship is our response to our Creator, our Saviour, our Sustainer, our eternal Hope of Glory. True worship comes from a heart of gratitude, humility and reverential submission to the One who is worthy. God is truly honoured as we offer our lives as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to Him. As Romans 12:1 says, “this is your true and proper worship”.		
APPLICATION QUESTIONS:			
Adult:	Do you have moments when you find that life (e.g. work, family, ministry) has become a routine rather than worship to God? Come back to commune with the Lord. Apart from Him, we can do nothing.		
Youth:	Can you recall one worship experience that you knew your heart's desire and life priority was shifted to Jesus? Describe it to someone or journal it down, and thank God for His good work in you. Continue to let God show you His heart for you and others, and receive His grace to live for Him.		
Child:	Describe what you love about your best friend? Pray and tell God what you love about Him. Doesn't God sound like how you would describe a best friend to be? Thank Jesus for being our BFF (Best Friend Forever).
