²³ <i>The chief cup-bearer, however, did not remember Joseph; he forgot him.</i>	<p>I am reminded that I cannot put my future in man but God alone. Joseph thought that the cup-bearer may help him get out from the prison but, he forgotten about it. Joseph stayed 2 full years in prison because God was not finished with him yet. God is seldom too early and never late. Man does not determine my future. God is the one that determines my future. God is the one who knows what is best for you and me.</p> <p>I have a group of mentors and friends who always remind me to meet God alone; wait upon Him; study His Word and allow His peace to saturate my heart before making major decisions. God is seldom too early and never late. He always moves at the right time. I remember how God sent two persons during a mission trip to confirm my calling. The word came just at the right time. I discovered in my own spiritual journey that I cannot make any decision until God confirms with His Word. Learning to wait upon God's timing is indeed a journey of trusting God.</p> <p>In summary, we don't put our future in our own hands or others. We put it in God's hands.
