Title: "Our Unintentional Sin"

Summary of Chapter

God told the Israelites that when they sinned unintentionally and realize it later, they are guilty and will need to offer a sin offering. Unintentional sin can also be not doing things that we know is right according to Leviticus 5:1. Whether sin is intentional or not, sin once committed has an effect and thus must be addressed. This is applicable to everyone, and leaders have to offer a more expensive sacrifice to pay for their sin to reflect their higher position.

How does it speak to me?

²⁷ 'Now if anyone of the common people sins unintentionally in doing any of the things which the LORD has commanded not to be done, and becomes guilty, ²⁸ if his sin which he has committed is made known to him, then he shall bring for his offering a goat, a female without defect, for his sin which he has committed.

It is indeed a high call for all to live a sinless life. As Christians, we have the Holy Spirit who reveal to us our unintentional sin.

I recall an incident recently when the Holy Spirit convicted me that I sinned unintentionally. During an online Grace AOG service, as I was sitting down comfortably during the worship session, the Holy Spirit spoke to me. He said that I was just singing along in my comfortable posture and just giving God outward lip service, but my heart was far away. I felt convicted. Since that day, whenever there is online service, I would always stand up and make it a point to truly worship God with my heart. With that, I was able to sense His presence deep within me even though it was just an online service.

We thank God that we no longer need to offer sacrifices for our unintentional sin because we have an all-encompassing redemption through the sacrifice of Christ. Let us allow the Holy Spirit to reveal unintentional sin in our lives so that we can repent and receive God's forgiveness through Christ.

APPLICATION REFLECTIONS
