

the person and work of the Holy Spirit

Here's the concluding article on the Person and Work of the Holy Spirit by Rev Paul Epton.

Pastor Paul has ministered with the Elim Pentecostal Churches of Great Britain for over 45 years. As the founding Pastor of Wirral Christian Centre he has been able to plant 21 Churches in the UK, as well as Churches, Schools, orphanages and mission clinics in many countries throughout Africa, also in India and Poland.

Preaching and teaching in over twenty countries he is also the author of 'Love in Action' describing the role he has played in dealing with Social issues which have led to Homes for the Elderly and Nurseries for younger children, and employment for a large number of people.

Pastor Epton ministered to us powerfully in a Sunday service at Furama Hotel last year and many were touched by his ministry.

The ministry of the Holy Spirit is truly amazing. Jesus said in John 14:16 that 'the Father will give you another counsellor.' The word for counsellor is so much more than advisor or helper, it speaks of one who will stand as at your side when you are in trouble with the law.

It is this aspect of the ministry of the Holy Spirit which we will briefly look at. Firstly, we remember that the Holy Spirit has many ministries to the Church and to the world at large. In John 16: 7-16, we see the Holy Spirit coming to 'convict' the world of sin, righteousness and judgement. In addition to this ministry to us, it is also important for us to keep a daily walk with God and to be filled daily with the power of the Holy Spirit.

In Paul's teaching to the Romans he shows us some truths which open our minds even further to yet another ministry of the Holy Spirit. Paul talks in Romans 8:25 about hope, and because we hope for what we do not have we wait patiently. There is so much more in Christ for you and me. Paul then expands upon this and shows us that not only is the Spirit helping you to wait in hope, but the Spirit is coming alongside you to actually do what you cannot do. In other words He takes over when you can go no further; look at verses 26 -27, 'but the Spirit himself intercedes for us'.

This is so clear - the Holy Spirit is praying for you, and more! He is praying with you, and though you are weak, He is strong. No, more than strong! He actually takes your prayer at the point where you can go no further and He intercedes for you. He does so, 'with groans that words cannot express'.

It is so helpful to remember that when we come to the end of ourselves, and praying in our native language comes to its end, then speaking in tongues is the Heaven-sent extension to your prayer life. No wonder Paul says in 1 Corinthians 14:18 'I speak in tongues more than you all'. And yet he teaches here in Romans that beyond our prayer life, and beyond that 'extension' to prayer life in tongues, there is a further ministry - the ministry of God the Holy Spirit. He is doing what you cannot do, He is praying what you cannot pray, you are not on your own.

There is a key to accessing this amazing support, and it starts in your prayer life:

- Pray indeed 'pray without ceasing', and have a meaningful prayer life everyday
- Tongues use the gift God has given you, and if you as yet are not 'baptised in the Holy Spirit' seek this urgently with all your heart
- Remember the Holy Spirit will take over at the end of your own prayer
- He will minister in verse 27 we see that He will search our hearts and He will intercede for the saints in accordance with God's will

When you have prayed, and fully given over your heart and your hearts desires, then you rely and even depend upon the truth of verse 28, 'We know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose.'

The Holy Spirt is our comforter, counsellor, guide, and so much more. He will give you 'power' - the power to live for Jesus in your world, the power and ability to walk this world in righteousness. Truly the Holy Spirit makes the difference between mediocrity and living the dynamic Christian life.

You never reach a destination without starting the journey. So, receive the Holy Spirit, maintain a positive prayer life, use the gifts God has given. And grow, progressing to become the child of God He has destined you to be.


ACTS OF THE MISSIONAL SPIRIT



Speaker's Profile:

Dr Naomi Dowdy is a pioneer missionary. More than forty years ago, she made the shift from being a business woman in California to become a young missionary to the Marshall Islands. Moving from island to island to preach the gospel, she battled loneliness and culture shocks, while breaking open coconuts for food and drink. During that time, she built churches, a Bible School and dormitories. Her responsibilities were as wide and varied as the islands of Micronesia across which she traveled to nurture church planting sites.

En route to her next assignment, she stopped over in Singapore, where she was approached to pastor a church with, as she puts it, 42 members and 75 problems. She heard the audible voice of God to take on the assignment, to move from the role of an evangelist to that of a pastor. After arguing with God (and losing that argument), she became the interim pastor.


The 'interim' period turned out to be almost 30 years. By the time she turned the church over to her spiritual sons and daughters, Trinity Christian Centre in Singapore had grown into a church of global impact, with more than 4000 in attendance, a global missions program and three freehold properties in the land-scarce city state. Today, Dr. Dowdy is helping a new generation of leaders fulfill God's calling upon their lives. She mentors church leaders, business leaders, and men and women in strategic leadership positions. She is inspiring and raising a new generation of world-changers.

FamilyLife@Grace

Parenting LIFE

What does an ideal Christian family look like? Some may associate characteristics such as warm, fun, safe, loving, trustworthy, respectful, and committed and all things positive with it. Although it is unrealistic to perfect all families in Grace, the Parenting LIFE Division of the FamilyLife@Grace Ministry aims to do our utmost best in preventing families in Grace from sliding away from our Christian faith. We truly believe that when Christ is the unseen head of the household, nothing can stand against it.

We acknowledge that many parents in Singapore find it a struggle to spend enough quality time with their children. In the past, we organized several events, such as an overnight father-and-son camp, a 3D2N Kukup fishing trip and a durian feasting tour in Johor Bahru, with the sole aim of encouraging families in Grace to bond with their loved ones. This year, we are raising our bar. We want our efforts in strengthening families to create more impact by steering families in Grace to be the ideal Christian families of faith.

Mindful that every one of us can be attacked by the devil in all domains of our lives, it is critical for the Parenting LIFE Division of the FamilyLife@Grace Ministry to equip families in Grace to practise faith at home. Many of us have the illusion that our own family is safe from the devil's attack. We may have ignored any crack that has already existed in our family life but ignorance is not bliss. Christian divorce rate is upsurging as the devil works hard in destroying Christian families. He probably knows that the best way to stop God's redemption plan is by breaking down Christian families.

FamilyLife@Grace is working on strengthening faith at home by building family values on the mighty Word of God. For instance, we are going to develop devotional materials that are

appropriate for use by families who are active in the cell groups. We are also planning to write educational books pertaining to a wide range of issues, such as sexuality education from the Christian perspective.

In February, FamilyLife@Grace and the Children's Ministry organized multiple sharing sessions for parents whose children just started their primary education. In one of the sessions on 23 February, 26 parents and guardians were present for the very first *Primary One Transition Sharing Session* organised by both ministries. The adults sat in the children's worship, followed by a testimony by Brother Kenneth who shared his personal ten year series (TYS) for the Primary One children. He talked about the child's needs, beyond the academic ones, and encouraged the participating parents to be good models and play an active role in guiding their children at various phases of their lives.

In another session, Sister Lynde shared how she trained her children to be more self-regulated in their learning. While giving her testimony of God's work in her children's lives, she gave the parents just-in-time techniques in raising responsible and obedient children.

I also presented the worrying trend of adolescents dropping out of church. In each of the sharing sessions, participating parents were introduced to the FamilyLife@Grace library (currently, only available at G2) and our Facebook page that is currently a closed group set up to encourage and motivate those in our contact list.

We hope to see more Grace families joining us in the

future. In the month of July, FamilyLife@Grace and the Children Ministry are collaborating again to organize a fun-filled family outing for the children and their parents. Look out for more information about it in the months to come! See you there!

Sir Kiang and Kate's Testimony

Both of us were brought up in dysfunctional homes. When we were blessed with a pair of twin girls, we wanted to parent our kids right and be answerable to God. We set this as our top priority.

Being new parents at that time, we were clueless in parenting. However, we made it a point to attend parenting workshops, including those organised by Grace. Our very first parenting workshop took place in Johor Bahru. It was a 2D1N event. We remembered the speaker shared about the importance of prayer and family devotion. After the workshop, we started to

practise faith at home by praying as a family when our kids started to talk. To date, we continue to pray for one another before we sleep.

Every Sunday is family devotional time. We usually start with worship and prayer and then share what we have heard from God

during the week. Many times, it's our children who teach us about the child-like faith. For instance, there was once we were encouraged when the girls shared how they managed to find their lost stationery in school after praying to God fervently. It may seem to be a small matter but that incident has taught us that God is always interested in all areas of our lives.

By praying together with our children, we learn about the problems they face at school, such as involving in disputes with their classmates, being misunderstood by their teachers and facing exam stress. Such unreserved sharing from them are teachable moments for us as parents, as we watch how God intervenes in their lives.

As parents, we have emphasized the importance of attending Children Church and being grounded in the Word of God. Although our twins are currently 17 years old, they still remember



workshop 16 years ago. We know we can expect more from God and do more for God through FamilyLife@Grace. To God be the glory!

Hearts that listen

My 9 year old son was reading his Bible story on Rahab and the spies. He asked why did Rahab lie? Why was it acceptable? (Joshua 2:4-6). How do you teach Biblical principles to young kids like him?

Based on the principle that God loves the sinner but condemns the sins, it was wrong for Rahab to lie. Even though she sinned by lying, she was accepted by God for her faith and obedience. In that case, you could say that Rahab lied for a good cause, it was still a sin that was unacceptable to God.

Children should be taught never to lie but always be honest to admit their mistakes. They have to be taught that two wrongs will never make one right.
