# PERSONAL RENEWAL

At the Grace Retreat, I mentioned that Grace is embarking on 5 areas of renewals. They are Personal, Relational, Missional, Structural and Cultural renewals. For the church to move forward strongly, these 5 areas of renewal are critical to the overall health of the church.

Let me briefly highlight what Personal Renewal is.

As a church, the heart of the matter is in fact a matter of the heart. It definitely has to start with the heart. The first and most important renewal is the renewal of the heart.

In the Book of Revelation, Jesus described the condition of the heart of the church of Laodicea as lukewarm. Jesus said, 'I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other. So because you are lukewarm - I am about to spit you out of my mouth' Rev. 3:15-16. Surely what the church at Laodicea needs is a renewal of heart, from a lukewarm one to a heart that is on fire for Jesus.

When we are complacent, Christianity can be reduced to 'churchianity', a ritual, a religion and a stagnant relationship with the Lord. Spiritual renewal can only occur when we realize our need for greater intimacy with Jesus and that we desire a closer relationship with Him.

A healthy, vibrant and intimate growing walk with God is the result of a life deeper in prayer, the reading and studying of the Bible, a growing excitement for the things of God, a renewed vision of the cross and a greater awareness of His presence.

For Grace to be strong spiritually, the renewal must begin with me, you and then with the rest of the church. You can call it a rededication of your life, a deeper life, or a fresh infilling of the Holy Spirit. The bottom line is to fall in love with Jesus again!

This is what I call a Personal Renewal - renewed from the inside out.

My prayer is that every Gracian will experience this Personal Renewal and in turn, the whole church walking in the path of renewal. When this happens, there will be greater breakthroughs in our lives, families and the church as a



# Spiritual Gifts: You may already be exercising them! – Part 1

Ministering spiritual gifts is not as mystical as you might think.

Paul uses the word "charismata" to refer to both the ministries we have and the more spontaneous gifts: a word of wisdom, knowledge, healings, miracles, tongues, and interpretation, etc.

Many of you can already identify with ministries you participate in as teaching, hospitality (helps), administrations, missionaries (apostle), pastors, evangelists and Grace Group leadership. In these ministries you have found favor with people as the Spirit anoints you. You discover a gift of leadership, or organizational strength, or ability to build bridges to people or to communicate God's truth. All true ministry is impartation of life. When you, under the anointing of the Holy Spirit, pour your life into people's lives, you are ministering the gifts of the Spirit.

One of the great misunderstandings is that the gifts are all supernatural and have nothing to do with man. But the gifts of the Spirit are incarnational—God working through man. For example, Jesus is fully God and fully man. The Bible is God's book, yet it is man's book. Men wrote, under the inspiration of God, the authoritative Word of God. That is why we have 4 gospels, not just one. Each one wrote with his vocabulary, his style, for his purpose, yet God watched over its accuracy and inspiration. The church is a divine institution, yet a human institution. Jesus said, "I will build my church and the gates of hell will not prevail against it." Yet those of us who work with the church know how human it is! Even speaking in tongues has the divine part and the human part. Acts 2:4—they spoke as the Spirit gave utterance. There is divine-human cooperation.

The formula looks like this: Sharing (by word or action) + Holy Spirit anointing + love= spiritual gift! In other words, step out by faith! You do your part humbly and in love, share it with others under the anointing of God and watch what God can do!

# a missions trip to Hyderabad



n the last week of May, seven of us from R-AGE embarked on a missions trip to Hyderabad. We went on a mission to engage the youth leaders of Sharon AG church and to equip them with the knowledge of running youth programmes. India is very different from Singapore in many ways. Perhaps the one thing we found hardest to adjust to was the food. It was not because the food was bad. In fact, it was absolutely savoury and delectable! But every meal has a side of curry and every dish has some form of spice in it.

The fiery food there is a good representation of their passion. When they gathered to worship, they held nothing back. The sound systems were at full volume and their voices were no softer. They danced in worship with a passion that left us breathless. Their passion to serve God was also evident in their lifestyle. Many of them sacrificed job opportunities so that they could attend service on the weekends whilst others chose to live nearby to better serve the church. The most commendable of them all were the ones who responded to full-time calling into the village mission field. These lone pastors head out into the remote villages facing cultural differences, language barriers and even persecution that can lead to death. All for the good news.

And so having met these amazing people, we felt like the boy who only had five loaves and two fishes. But as we offered up the little that we have, God amazed us. On the last night of the youth camp, as all 200 of them were rallied together in fervent prayer, we sensed that God was doing something, but could not pinpoint what it was. We then had the chance to minister to the pastors. It was a faith stretching and humbling experience but many of us found ourselves prophesying into their lives. For both parties, it was such a refreshing time! Later we found out that many individuals had a 'burning bush' encounter that night. We were greatly encouraged to find that God is burning in them a new passion, one that will not burn out.

All in all, I learnt not to look to what is seen but to focus on the unseen. God had done more than I could imagine. He gave me a glimpse of what He is doing in the international scene through this truly unique cultural experience. With my eyes opened, I remain excited to see people of all nations rise up to be salt and light. To God be all the glory forever and ever!

I am blessed to be a part of my family which consist of both my parents, and a younger brother. Both my parents are faithfully serving as full time ministers in Malaysia

since the 1970s and have a great influence in my life. I am also blessed to be able to marry Regina and of whom I have the great privilege of serving full time with in Grace Assembly.

I came to know and accept the Lord at 2 years old. I grew up watching miracles take place as my parents ministered and yet I also saw the challenges of ministry. At the age of 12, I was sure that there was a distinct call upon my life. There was a distinct holy discontent about the worship that I could see happening around in churches. However, due to the painful ministry experiences while growing up and the financial struggles we had, I rejected that call for a few years.

At the age of 15, God moved during worship at a church camp. There was a sound of a violent rushing wind in the tent where we met, much like the Pentecost account in Acts. I couldn't hold back all my emotions and struggles of running from God's call. I yielded and God assured me through Romans 8:28 that He would provide for my family.

Thereafter, I was encouraged by my parents to work in the marketplace to experience life before starting ministry, where I worked professionally as a musician. But soon after making a successful living then, I was convinced it was time to drop everything and go full time and rely on the Lord.

I pursued both my music and theological education at two separate colleges. On the first day of studying, I was struck with a sudden deafness on my right ear that partially took my hearing away from me. No doctor could provide any explanation. Trusting the Lord, I prod on, believing that God who has brought me to music and gave me a heart for worship would work together all this for good. Not soon after, I was offered the opportunity to serve in Grace.

I have served in the Creative Arts Ministry (CAM) in Grace Assembly for over 6 years now. In CAM, I basically oversee GII worship, the singers, choir, musicians, songwriting and dancers. 



During the month of July, we had mission trips going out every weekend to the Riau Islands. We praise the Lord for your commitment to missions. One particular highlight is Ps Ben Koh's training trip to Kazakhstan where the focus is to consolidate the strength among the existing Kazakh pastors, as the persecution has been really intense for the past few months. Many of them are very exhausted.

I happened to be in India right after their recent elections. The political-religious climate over South Asia is changing. With the newly elected anti-Christian government in India, the Christians in the region are bracing for tough times ahead. The situation in Nepal is also affected. Now the frequent strikes that used to be of political agenda is starting to have a religious tint, targeting churches. The Hindu extremist are borrowing power from the ruling political party in India to

campaign against the Church with the agenda of driving Christians away from Nepal, the officially Hindu nation.

Given the impending hardship ahead, the spiritual climate however is stronger than ever. Despite the persecution, Christianity is growing in strength and in numbers. Wherever we minister in, the Holy Spirit showed up strongly in their churches. There is a resurgence of the Holy Spirit's activity over South Asia. Increasingly, our mission trippers who went there, came back with reports of signs and wonders accompanied by testimonies of healings and casting out of demons.

God is preparing believers in the region to withstand persecution, growing them in faith and in long suffering. The Holy Spirit is rousing up a spiritual army. The Lord is bringing about a shift in the spiritual atmosphere and this revival will come neither by might, nor by power, but by Holy Spirit.

"But the Lord stood at my side and gave me strength, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed and all the Gentiles might hear it.

And I was delivered from the lion's mouth." - 2 Timothy 4:17

Continue to pray for the persecuted churches, that God would strengthen them, and the Church would be a shining beacon of light in dark places. Pray with us, for our trippers to be used mightily by the Lord as they minister with the power of the Holy Spirit.


A LIBERT OF PROSE
