Firstly, His amazing provision for the Redevelopment of Grace Assembly. It's a miracle by itself the we have \$4 million in savings from various tenders. Now, the cost of the Redevelopment is \$62 million instead of \$66 million. Praise the Lord! The shortfall now stands at \$5.3 million. The figure is slowly but surely coming down.

As I have mentioned, we want to believe God that we will step into the new building debt free. It has been a journey of faith and let's continue to commit this journey to the Lord. My prayer is that this shortfall of \$5.3 million will be fully met by the end of this year. Let us look to God that He will provide and will use each one of us as the conduit of His provision.

This Redevelopment journey has been a miracle in itself and I'm thankful to God that we are all part of this miracle.

Secondly, I'm so thankful for the turnout of both the Chinese and English Grace Retreats. We had a total of 1,271 Gracians at both Retreats and it's the highest attendance in all these years.

The Holy Spirit moved powerfully at both of these Retreats. I saw upraised hands, fervent intercession, liberated worship, bended knees and tearful eyes at the Retreats. Many were also baptized with the Holy Spirit. Most of all, there were many surrendered hearts, renewed commitments to the Lord, powerful breakthroughs and different ones experiencing the power of the Holy Spirit as the Spirit touched them.

There's a great renewal and revival taking place and it'll bring about a powerful impact to the church at large.

I'm thankful for what the Lord has done in the hearts of Gracians at the Retreats and what He is going to do in Grace in the days ahead.

All glory to the Lord!

They spend Saturday afternoons befriending lonely older folk in one of Singapore's poorest housing estate, Lengkok Bahru. They regularly contribute food and other necessities that they pay from their own pockets. Volunteers also hold tuition sessions for children in primary school from the same blocks.

It's an endeavor that also involves young children. Raymond's primary one son Justin and his classmates have visited and distributed food at the block.

We want to applause the missional spirit exhibited by them and pray that their efforts will be felt significantly by the needy in that area.

# sermons for 3rd quarter

**ACTS OF THE** MISSIONAL SPIRIT: Expansion of the Church on His Mission Acts 9-28

As the early church continued to grow, the apostles faced the challenges of taking the gospel beyond the shores of Israel. The way they followed the leading of the Holy Spirit and persevered in trials and opposition are powerful examples and lessons for us as we embrace the mission of God in our lives. We discover that we are all part of His story and the Acts of Missional Spirit is continued in us as we seek to live our lives missionally for His glory.

Every Christian is to be a witness. We are not all evangelists, but we have a responsibility to evangelize. We are to live the Christian life in front of people and tell them about the gospel of Jesus Christ. "The baptism in the Spirit means that people, saved by grace, and born again can have new experiences and become Spirit-energized witness for Christ."

After Jesus Christ was resurrected He told His disciples to "wait for the gift my Father promised" (Acts 1:4). This gift is for every believer in the world today. You may disagree with us on some points of terminology and perhaps some theology, but we hope that we all hold this one thing in commonnamely, that we want a deeper, richer, more powerful experience of God's Spirit. You might call it "baptism", "fullness," or the "infilling of the Holy Spirit." Whatever your terminology, we pray that you experience it.

Some, like the house of Cornelius (see Acts 10), received the experience within seconds after their conversion. Others may have been Christians for decades without ever having heard that there was such an experience. The point is not so much *when* you hear of this tremendous promise or *how* you receive it; it is that you take advantage of all that God has for you.


Some people have tried to say that the baptism in the Spirit with signs following was only for the early disciples who needed the extra "charge" or unique gifting to get Christianity started. Well, we need it too! It is critical that we utilize every available bit of energy and supernatural strength to do God's work in an evil world.

God's power is for you and me today. His wonderful gift is available to us just as it was to the early church. You can receive the same power with signs following that the early church received. There simply is no biblical support for the opinions of some who say this experience is not for us. It is for today, and it can be a part of your life. D.L.Moody said," God commands us to be filled with the Spirit; and if we aren't filled, it's because we're living beneath our privileges." Peter said to the thousands of onlookers, "The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off - for all whom the Lord our God will call" (Acts 2:39). Let us examine Peter's words.

- 1. The promise us "for you." The people whom Peter was talking to were the same ones he had accused of putting Jesus to death by "nailing him to the cross" (Acts 2:23). The very people responsible for all killing Jesus were being offered the gift of the baptism in the Holy Spirit. God wanted them to know that he would forgive them if they repented, and he would give the same experience that the 120 had received in the Upper Room. (See Acts 1:13; 2:1.)
- 2. The promise is for "your children." It is to be passed on from generation to generation. Christianity is not a one-generation religion. God has no grandchildren, only children. Also, God does not want us to think that this experience was only for people many generations ago. Peter was telling his listeners that this promise was for their children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and so on. Paul prayed for a group of Ephesian disciples to receive the baptism in the Holy Spirit approximately twenty years after the original disciples had had the experience. (See Acts 19:1-7.) The word "children" not only means our immediate families, but also our descendants. We are descendants of the early church. Their experience can be ours.
- 3. The promise is for "all who are far off" (Acts 2:39). Perhaps he was prophetically speaking about the Christians who would be alive when the rapture of the church occurred. Looking down through the ages, Peter's spiritual eyes may have had a glimpse of today's church. We are "far off" in time and space.
- 4. The promise is "for all whom the Lord our God will call" (Acts 2:39). God's call to salvation is for everyone. He "wants all men to be saved and come to a knowledge of the truth" (1 Tim. 2:4). Jesus said, "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him" (John 6:44). He later added, "No one can come to me unless the Father has enabled him" (v.65). The Father draws us to Jesus, and the Father has given the guarantee that not only would those who come to Christ receive salvation, but "the promise" would be available to them too. We who have salvation are the ones the "Lord our God will call" (Acts 2:39). You can have your own personal experience. In fact, God does not want to watch those who have had powerful experiences in the Lord. He wants this baptism for you just as much as he does for anyone else.

### STORIES OF OUR CAMELS: ELAINE TAN (KV, Youth)

I have been serving in the ministry over the past year in R-AGE as a KV. Being in this ministry has allowed me to grow in many ways. I never knew what it really means to 'sing a new song onto the Lord', until one day the Holy Spirit placed a melody in my heart and I sang it out in faith. It felt different, but in a wonderful way. You must know that anyone can sing in the Spirit, it is not limited to just the people serving in the worship team.

I still come to the Lord in fear and trembling every time that I serve, but there is an added excitement in my heart, knowing that I can encounter with God through worship leading. There is a joy that fills my heart, a joy that I wished I could transfer to everyone around me, every time I serve the Lord in this manner. But you have got to experience it for yourself. If the Lord has given you gifting's (be it playing an instrument, percussion or simply singing) in these areas, join us!

#### THERESA LEONG (Praise Singers, Choir)

Looking back, I am thankful to God for using me in the choir ministry.

Initially, I was doubtful that I could make such a commitment. As joining the choir meant that I needed to make adjustments to my weekend plans with my family members as well as working hard on singing correctly, stretching my memory power.

However, God opened the door for me to serve not just once, but twice in 2 different occasions so that I could respond. What I enjoyed most is seeing things work out through God and experiencing God, who enabled me time and time again through many circumstances.

Every rehearsal is a challenge, but also a blessing. It is especially so when there are parts to learn and lyrics to memorize and arising very early in the morning and travelling down to GII in preparation for the morning services. But the challenges are nothing when compared to the surpassing joy and blessings I received in singing for Him.

I would like to thank CAM for scheduling good training programs and workshops that have helped us improve in our singing skills and Bible study and admonishing us to draw closer to God even in our personal walk with Him in worship.

The church has also specifically prayed over us, the Worship ministry team, in a J333 meeting in Sept 2012, and I experienced His anointing in worship. These experiences are something I will always treasure for the rest of my life.

#### **DAVID TAN (Praise Audio)**

Personally, I find it a privilege to be called into serving and especially the Praise Audio ministry. I am always reminded of the Levites in the Old Testament who were set aside by God and given the task of ministering to the people in the sanctuary. They were also making sure the tent of meeting is ready for the people to worship and fellowship with God.

Through serving, I learnt that all my effort and knowledge is meaningless until it is directed towards bringing believers closer to God and laying claim to the atmosphere in Jesus' name, so the sounds from every voice and every instrument will be used by the Holy Spirit to minister to the people and draw them to God. This helps create worship that rises like sweet incense to the Lord. Like the song says, "Better is one day in Your courts than thousands elsewhere". There is nothing better than worshipping God, and having the privilege to play a role in it.

#### LIN WEI BIN (Praise Band, Electric Guitar)

Being able to serve in CAM as a guitarist has been one of the greatest privileges from God and from the ministry in my life. After serving for 13 years, God renewed my passion to play for him because I draw nearer to Him with my instrument. The song 'Endless Hallelujah' by Matt Redman speaks of my heart because worship is what we will be doing forever in heaven, and it is His irresistible grace that draws me to Him. Worship on earth is merely a small continuation to, or as what Pastor Lim used to always say, 'rehearsal' for eternity. This keeps me really excited!

As I looked back, it was CAM that helped develop my gift. Far better than that, it was CAM that deepened my walk with God. These two outcomes are what I have to be more than thankful for. God never short-changes our service to Him!

#### MINISTRY ROLE'S AND DESCRIPTIONS:

These descriptions below are to furnished you with a little information about what the ministry is like and what is the commitment level required

#### PRAISE SINGERS

#### Choir

The choir is the extended arm of the congregation that is trained to support the worship with vocal presence that symbolizes and anticipates the multitude of worshippers in Revelation. The choir rehearses weekly for both the weekend services and for special worship occasions throughout the year.

Choir's member's requirements and commitments are as follows:

- To attend a simple audition and interview to ascertain vocal range and ministry commitment capacity
- Faithful in attending weekly choir practice on Saturday and project rehearsals as required
- Serves in the Sunday worship backup team on alternate weeks in GI/II at 9am and 11.15am
- Participates in all special projects/ presentations undertaken by the choir
- Possesses a humble and teachable spirit and faithful in prayer
- Possesses some degree of musical singing ability and to learn to sing in parts
- Diligent in spending effort and time in memorizing and internalizing the worship songs
- Good stewards of resources entrusted to the choir such as attire/accessories, score sheet, song booklets, practice CDs and music tracks for ministry purposes

#### KV (Key Vocalist)

The Key Vocalist is an important element in the worship team, supporting the Worship Leader alongside the musicians in leading worship lyrically.

Key Vocalists requirements and commitments are as follows:

- Possess an exemplary servant attitude
- Good vocal technique in Tone & Expression
- A good ear for harmonies, and blending
- Preferably music theory knowledge
- Attend Band rehearsals adequately prepared with lyrics memorized

#### **PRAISE AUDIO**

Praise Audio is a dynamic team where you will experience worship like never before. You will go through a structured training program covering modern audio equipment, mixing techniques and to support the worship leaders/musicians in creating the right ambience so the congregation can draw closer to God during worship and ensuring the spoken word is delivered with clarity.

Praise Audio's requirements and commitments are as follow:

- To attend band rehearsal for scheduled weekends on Tuesday (GI), Wednesday (Youth/YAYP) or Thursday (GII)
- Serve on scheduled weekend services at GI/ GII and other events

#### PRAISE VISUAL

Praise Visual team provide visual support for worship and sermons during regular services and events. With the use of computers and cameras, multimedia content (song lyrics, powerpoint slides, videos) are projected behind the scenes by these dedicated team. Praise Visual Roles: Video Switcher, Camera Operator, Projectionist and more.

Praise Visual's requirements and commitments are as follow:

- To attend band rehearsal for scheduled weekends on Tuesday (GI) or Thursday (GII)
- Serve on scheduled weekend services at GI/ GII and other events

#### PRAISE PRODUCTION

Praise Production is the ministry that join the dots between various ministries (Visuals, Audio, Lights, Emcees, Worship Team, etc.) to ensure smooth operations and running of regular services and events. These individual plays the role of managing, coordinating and executing productions effectively.

Praise Production Roles: Stage Manager, Production Manager, Production Assistant, Crew Member and more.

Praise Production's requirements and commitments are as follow:

- A good communicator and organizer
- Possess a spirit of excellence, detailed, dependable and solution-minded
- Serve on scheduled weekend services at GI/ GII and other events

#### Creative Arts Ministry recruitment month continued.

#### **PRAISE BAND**

Praise Band is the ministry of musicians that are there to support the congregational worship singing for all services. These bands of musicians form the core foundation to our ministry of worship to God through their music every weekend and in most of our services.

Band member's requirements and commitments are as follow:

- To audition with two songs of different genres and demonstrate the ability to learn and play current worship songs
- To understudy (for approximately a period of 3 months) someone to learn and understand the culture and commitment of serving in the worship team.
- To attend band rehearsal for scheduled weekends on Tuesday (GI), Wednesday (Youth/YAYP) or Thursday (GII)

- Serve on scheduled weekend services at GI/GII
- Have the ability to play in a contemporary modern music band situation
- Possess some ability to know and learn the reading of notes and scores
- To be committed to be good stewards of God's resources (church instruments, scores, etc.)

Musicians needed: Keyboardists, Electric Guitarists, Acoustic Guitarists, Bassists, Drummers or any other instruments that are relevant in a contemporary music setting

#### **INSTRUMENTALISTS**

This is a new ministry to gather church musicians who are adept in playing instrumental/orchestral music. The ministry desires to creatively learn and develop instrumentalists to complement musical dynamics in worship to demonstrate the marvellous God we worship.

Instrumentalist requirements and commitments are as follow:

- Church members who possess relevant orchestral/ensemble instrumental music skills
- Instruments that are relevant: any String, Brass, Woodwind instruments
- Pass audition, consisting of a choice of your own selected piece and a given sight-reading
- Music will be sent in advance to members to practise individually, so that they can be prepared to play, not learn, during rehearsal
- Fortnightly practices (suggested timings: Tues 7.30-10pm / Sat 9.30am – 12pm) at GII
- Playing for special services (i.e. Easter, Christmas etc.) or as needed for weekly worship services



I believe that the blessings that I have in this present life must be shared with others. This world is temporal but eternity is forever, thus I choose to place my investments of time and resources there.







I believe Grace Retreat 2014 has been a significant spiritual milestone for the youths of Grace Assembly. Over five days, 220 youths descended upon Malaysia's Palace of the Golden Horses hotel, to meet God and bond as a body.

When we come with expectant hearts, God never fails to show up; His presence was tangibly evident at every service, and we experienced spiritual revival, as many youths received the baptism of the Holy Spirit, saw visions, and experienced spiritual restoration.

Rev. Julie Khoo, from Glad Tidings AG, Petaling Jaya, was such a blessing to us. She always moved spontaneously in the Spirit and delivered prophetic words when led to; at one service, she was led to give a response call for those with full-time calling, and 23 youths of all ages received, and responded to God's call! No words can encompass the great work He has done in R-AGE; we can only thank and praise God!

Retreat also brought youths from our GI and GII communities together to form new bonds, as we underwent an experience unique only to R-AGE: boys were made to put on make up, while girls donned camouflage cream, as their war paint, to play a series of exhilarating, vivacious games – we drenched each other using just a sponge, and ran laps just to collect sweat – which climaxed with a mass dog-and-bone game, where teams fought an all-out battle of speed and wits to be the first team to collect cards and complete a mystery phrase.

I am certain that R-AGE walked away with fresh revelation of God, and new friendships that will last. All these were accomplished not by the efforts of the leaders, but by the grace and love of God, and it is my prayer that the youths will walk away from this retreat remembering having encountered God, and being transformed by Him.

What is important from here on, is that we apply what we have learned during this retreat, taking steps daily to enrich our relationship with God. We must continue to be consistent in prayer, and press into His presence daily, that we will be renewed by the Spirit, and transact the fire to the rest of R-AGE, and the rest of our nation.

I believe that when the Spirit comes, we WILL redeem a generation for eternity.

Using professional therapies strengthened with Biblical principles, they will help you to achieve a victorious life in Christ.

These associate counsellors (volunteer counsellors) are our church members, professionally trained under the close supervision of the REACH COUNSELING - Community Services Society (RCSS) which is the community outreach arm of our church.

#### The Girl at the Corner

It was a Sunday evening. Su Min felt like running away. Even though her parents were discussing about financial matters on an amicable note, it stirred up a great turmoil within her heart.

The past image of her parents embroiled in escalating conflict flashed past her mind. The flashback paralysed her. Su Min realised that her old fears were still haunting her.

Su Min was 13 years old when she knew that her family was different. Her parents had been quarrelling over her father's infidelity. On several occasions, her mother had threatened suicide. This was a secret she could not share with anyone. Fear was her faithful companion that would usher her to hide at a dark corner. Now at 25, she thought she had grown out of this fear since her parents' issue was largely resolved and they have been relating well over the last four years.

Su Min was still terrified over the prospect of her mother killing herself and her father abandoning the family. Fear had crippled her in her own relationships. She realized that her rejection of her former boyfriend due to punctuality issue, arose from her need to protect herself from impending disappointment and hurt. Just as she felt that her father had not taken good care of her mother and her, she could not bear the thought of being vulnerable to another relationship that might let her down. Whenever someone lets her down, fear would lead her to cut off the relationship prematurely. She would then retreat to that safe and familiar dark corner.

#### **Hearts that listen**

#### Question

My husband and I have been married for many years now. We love children and would very much like to have one. We were very happy when we found out that I was pregnant. Like all first-time parents, we were shopping for the baby's things and were looking forward to having this baby. However, our joy was cut short. In one of our visit to the doctor, the baby's heart-beat was not detected. I had a miscarriage. We were both devastated. How could we move on from here?

#### **Pastor Walter Lim replies**

We are so sorry to hear about your loss. Losing someone we hold dear or care about is always painful and difficult. It is not what we would normally choose to go through, yet it is part and parcel of life's journey that we can never fully understand. I would like to answer your question with a two part answer.

#### How do I manage what I am feeling now?

Generally, I would see this as a situation of grief as you had lost someone dear to your heart. There are generally five stages of grief that a person may experience. Though not in the order of sequence or all the stages listed below:

- Denial: "No, this is not happening..."
- Anger: "Why me...why?"
- ... Bargaining: "If only I have done this or that ..."
- · Depression: "I don't feel like doing anything ..."
- · Acceptance: "Ok! How can I move on from here?"

As you go through the grief process, know that there is always healing as you allow yourself to look beyond the current situation. If you find yourself stopping at any of the above first four stages, go talk to someone who can hear you out and share your emotions. He or she can be a friend or a professional counsellor. You do not have to go through them all alone. As a Bible-believing Christian, you can always bring your grief to God in prayer. The Book of Psalms is full of such prayers for you to identify with. Once you come to accept the situation that he cannot change, you are now ready to move on to the next stage.

#### **Moving Forward**

1 Corinthians 13 gives us the definition of what love means and in verse 13, it says: "And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love." Faith, hope and love are strong motivational forces that invigorate us into facing our tomorrows. There must be good reasons why you want to start a family. Think of your loved ones that are still with you. Think of the God you believe in. His plans are not to harm you, though you may not understand them now. He wants to bless you. There are much teachings in the Bible to tell us that that is true. No one chooses to go through difficult moments, but they always make us a better person once we overcome them. Many of the important turning points of our lives are shared by challenging moments. Let the faith, hope and love in our God and the people around you and yourself be the very strength you can tap on to move on beyond where you are. There is a better tomorrow awaiting you as you leave your present and move towards a new future that awaits you.

Su Min took courage to step into the unknown by seeking help through counselling. She recalled, "The idea of undergoing counselling seems rather intimidating to me". It was not easy for Su Min to be in touch with her emotions and to confront her fears. Yet, she took the risk and became gradually aware of the link between her past and her fears. Therapies helped her to express her childhood injury, appreciate the "girl at the corner" and eventually to bid goodbye to her. In doing so, new companions could come alongside her. Courage and compassion are now her companions that light up her heart.

"I began to undergo a transformative process by allowing myself to first reduce my guardedness, be vulnerable, then to explore the past unresolved hurts and fears and eventually to make deliberate and resolute changes – albeit carried out in small, baby steps. I was able to shift the manner in which I think and react to differing situations, and I find myself being better able to relate to myself and my loved ones. I am now more able to get in touch with my own feelings and emotions, and am more effective in managing them. Through my experience, I have discovered that counselling is essentially a very important process which everybody may need to undergo at one point or another in their lives, in order to face one's fears and hurts, confront them, and to defeat them."

Su Min courageously faced her fears and took practical steps to relate better with her parents and her loved ones. She also learnt to nurture a compassionate and encouraging voice, and to reduce the critical voice within her. From a girl at a corner, she is growing to become a woman of courage and compassion.

he month of June was one of the hottest months for countries we have church planting works in. Some countries are experiencing temperature upwards of 40°c in the shade. Despite the sweltering heat, last month we sent off 3 short-term missions trips, we have conducted 4 leadership training sessions in our partner countries. All of a sudden, the Holy Spirit filled the entire room. Like a tide rushing in, breaking at the shore, everyone started to burst out in tongues from the back all the way to the front. Even those nursing mothers at the back of the room started bursting out in tongues!

This must be a work of God! I was the first foreigner they ever saw and they have never heard what tongues sounded like. Yet back there, everyone was praising God just like how we are experiencing it here in Grace Assembly.

My experience in Nepal tells me that what the Bible recorded in Acts 2 is not just a thing of the past. That experience is still available for us today! God is real, and God is pouring out His Spirit on all people in all nations. Pray with us, for our trippers to be used mightily by the Lord as they minister with the power of the Holy Spirit.
