A Great Challenge! A Great Opportunity!

In the history of Grace since 1950, God has always provided for us in every way, be it for ministries, missions, or manpower. Even in the area of facilities, the Lord has never failed to provide. Financially, we have always been blessed because God is faithful and Gracians are faithful givers.

We are now at a very challenging point where we need to raise \$15 million to pay off the whole redevelopment project. \$15 million is a lot of money. This is the biggest financial challenge for the church in all these years.

In our fundraising efforts thus far, we have never raised beyond \$10 million within a calendar year. Now we need to raise \$15 million. If not, the church has to borrow and that is an option we do not want to embark on. Any borrowing would mean an extra burden on the church, depending on how much we need to borrow and service the monthly loan installment for a period of time. To date, the church board had discussed about borrowing but have not gone into any active plans to do so as we believe we will not need to exercise this option.

As this is the biggest financial challenge, it also means it is the biggest opportunity for us to experience God. Yes, \$15 million is a lot but if every Gracian were to do their part, I believe God will do His big part.

The fact is that we only need to raise \$15 million presently is already a testament to the faithfulness of the Lord. The budget for the redevelopment is \$66 million and the Lord has already provided \$51 million, a huge amount! Surely, we can believe God for another \$15 million.

Let us commit this whole fund raising to the Lord. In fact, it's not just Fund Raising, but Faith Raising! The faith to believe we will enter into the new building debt free in 2015.

It is a journey of faith and thus far, our faith has been strengthened because we have experienced the wonderful provision of God.

Lord, you are our Jehovah Jireh!

receive the fullness of the Spirit

Pastor Paul has ministered with the Elim Pentecostal Churches of Great Britain for over 45 years. As the founding Pastor of Wirral Christian Centre he has been able to plant 21 Churches in the UK, as well as Churches, Schools, orphanages and mission clinics in many countries throughout Africa, also in India and Poland.

Preaching and teaching in over twenty countries he is also the author of 'Love in Action' describing the role he has played in dealing with Social issues which have led to Homes for the Elderly and Nurseries for younger children, and employment for a large number of people.

Pastor Epton ministered to us powerfully in a Sunday service at Furama Hotel last year and many were touched by his ministry.



Isn't it amazing that many Christians are willing to accept only a small portion of all that God has for them? Could you imagine taking just one third of your wages every month and allowing two-thirds to be lost?

Of course, we would not allow that to happen as we need all of our salary, and perhaps we would like a little more! The greater truth is that we need all that

God has for us, which is why Paul says to the Christians in Ephesus,

"Have you received the Holy Spirit since you believed" (Acts 19:2)

When I was eight years old I accompanied my parents to a prayer meeting. While I was praying, Jesus baptised me with the Holy Spirit and I began to 'speak in tongues'. Did I understand? No, I was eight! Did it transform me, though I was only a child? Yes! And immediately my love for Jesus grew in an amazing way. My desire to tell others of Jesus was insatiable, and before long I had led our neighbours to Jesus. Starting with the son and then his sister, then mum and finally dad.

Jesus said, "You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you" . And the teaching of Jesus in John and Acts helps us to understand how much we need the Holy Spirit. He is our

When we read in Luke 5:17 that 'the power of the Lord was present to heal them', we are reminded that when the Spirit is present there is a river flowing from the throne of God. It is the river of salvation, it is the river of healing, it is the river of His presence and 'in the presence of the Lord there is fulness of joy'. So it is right and good to feel a deep sense of peace, happiness and well-being when in the presence of the Holy Spirit.

Now the question has to be, where does that leave you? Or perhaps the best question to ask is the one found in Acts 19, 'have you received the Holy Spirit since you believed?' Let us then add a second question in line with Ephesians 5:18. Here we are encouraged to 'be [being] filled with the Holy Spirit'. That is to say that we need to constantly refresh ourselves in the Lord, we constantly need His power and presence - with us and in us. In our natural bodies we cannot live on the food we ate last week, month or year. In our spiritual selves it is the same - we need a fresh walk with God everyday. There is no substitute to your daily prayer life.

Sometimes you may hear people talking of a sermon heard months or even years ago as though it was the highest point of their spiritual life. How sad, for no matter how much we have enjoyed, there is always more! God always offers to us a greater tomorrow, and regardless of the highs and lows of life, with God it is always a journey to the 'greater' He has for us. Until finally one day we are in His presence in glory.



If you dream of performing, whether singing, dancing or acting, talk to us. Last year some members came out and blessed us with their willingness to share their passion. We hope to see more this year.




Truly, this is what family means – being in the house of God, to praise Him for His unconditional love and grace!

A couple of us went to Myanmar to run a regional youth leaders' conference. Prior to the missions trip I was feeling extremely

reluctant for a couple of reasons — I do not know if my skin condition would be able to handle the weather; it was my first missions trip ever and I felt that 6 days was pretty long for a first-timer like me. I barely knew the other people who were going on the trip with me and to top things off, we receive notification from the local pastor that our internal flight has been cancelled. There was no way into the northern region except through bus and train. Not just any bus and train journey but a 14-hour bus ride plus and a 21-hour train ride. Nothing seemed to be helping me look forward to this trip. It was only until I have finally sat down in the plane that I said a tiny prayer, "Lord I cannot run away already. Since I am here, just use me anyway, anyhow."

I was greatly humbled at the sight of the people's enthusiasm. So many people wanted to come that the church hosting us have to limit the number to around 2-3 leaders per church. There I was complaining about my plane-bus-train journey when a good quarter of the congregation actually took three days to journey here on motorbikes through jungles and rocky roads. Some even arrive one week earlier due to the uncertainty of the journey!

It was during the altar call for the baptism of the Holy Spirit that I witnessed the mighty move of the Holy Spirit amongst the congregation. Not that the Holy Spirit moved any lesser than here in Singapore, but over here in Myanmar the people just wanted more. The people were so hungry for more of God and because of that, the Holy Spirit's work was so evident that it was almost tangible to the senses.

After I surrendered my heart to God, he truly opened up my spiritual eyes to see how much God has blessed me. Reluctantly I go, reluctantly I come back home. I am humbled. God is so good to me!

This week we feature a simple dish which you can prepare and get the family to eat together. You are most welcome to share your simple recipes and it will be great to have a picture to go with it!

30 mins to prepare for a family of 4

1 packet pasta

5 garlic

4 tablespoon olive oil

3-4 slices bacon

500 gsm minced pork

1 packet of mozzarella cheese (shredded) cracked red peppers (optional)

Boil your pasta. (Follow timing on the packaging) While pasta is boiling, prepare the fillings

- Peel and chop up the garlic into small pieces or chucks if you like to bite them.
- 2. Cut the bacon into small pieces 1-2cm size.
- Heat up a pan with medium heat, add in the olive oil, garlic, bacon and minced pork.
- 4. Fry till meat are fully cooked.

For big shell pasta, scoop the fillings into each shell, sprinkle mozzarella cheese and bake in the oven at 180 C till cheese melt

For other pasta, toss them with the fillings, sprinkle mozzarella cheese and bake in the oven at 180 C till cheese melt

Using the big shell pasta makes meal time more fun for the family!
