

Encounter Weekend

Grace Discipleship Process (GDP) recently had run her annual Encounter Weekend again. For two full days, participants were equipped with three important topics: Baptism in the Spirit, Freedom & Identity in Christ, and Building Emotional Resilience.

Participants were taught from the Word of God on each of topics and had a chance to experience the works of God. At the teaching on the Baptism in the Spirit, we saw some receiving the baptism in the Spirit, others a new infilling, and yet others a word of prophesy or affirmation. The Lord moved in a sweet and gentle way, granting assurance of His greatest gift of the Holy Spirit to the participants. At the teaching on Freedom & Identity in Christ, participants renounced every past association with the occult and every ungodly tie. Encounter Weekend ended by allowing the Lord to heal our emotional hurts as the participants share in their small group. The sessions were planned in such a way that participants could continue to use their notes to further receive healing in their own timing.

Encounter Weekend is not just an experiential moment but encountering Jesus, the Truth Who sets us free from our old ways, and equips us for our journey with Him. We can then walk with others who need an encounter with the Lord too.

We pray that more and more Gracians, with their disciplers, will experience many moments of breakthroughs in the Lord. Encounter Weekend is a great place to start.



TAKING STOCK, PRAISING GOD BY PS MATTHEW TAN

A few more days and it would be Christmas, and yet a few more and we would be welcoming a new year. This is a good time for Grace Assembly to take stock of our foreign missions effort for 2016.

Propelling People

This year, by 31 December 2016, we would have sent a total of 97 missions teams out into the 11 countries where we have missions works. On our record, 454 of you have gone on at least one missions trip this year. This is amazing!

Preparing Leaders

Grace Missions believe in developing pastors and leaders in the missions field. This year close to 1,600 people have sat in our training classes during the 45 trips we made to conduct leadership training in the form of conferences and classes.



Planting Churches

This year, we supported the planting of 250 churches, making it a total of 1900 churches planted over 16 years. Praise the Lord!

Funds

As of 1 November 2016, we are grateful that we have raised close to S\$1.6 million for Grace Missions, way beyond our expectations! We thank God for His provision through all of who have taken up the challenge to believe in and give to the cause of foreign missions. This year being a difficult year in terms of finance, we truly appreciate your faithful giving.

Missions Conference 2017 will be held over the 21 - 22 January weekend. Do look out for it as it would be a special weekend where God will be challenging us to align our hearts and our plans to His missional heartbeat.

Some members of our Creative Arts Ministry went on a missions trip to Hyderabad, India from 10th to 17th October 2016. They ministered in a youth (worship) conference, visited local churches and ministered at different platforms — from singing and preaching at the pulpit, to sitting on the floor and joining the kids at various feeding programs.

Here we have Mei Anne, one of our first-time missions tripper, to share with us her experience.

GOD IS GOOD, ALL THE TIME, IN ALL PLACES

I looked outside our hotel window in India at the goats and their udders, and felt like an empty sheet of paper filled with quotes from others. My team were sort of pundits in their fields, be it their instrument of choice, teaching children, singing, healing the sick, or, well, churning out puns. Me? Most of the time, as a full-time writer and Grace Group leader, I feel like my words aren't even my own. I don't excel in anything and I'm a copy of a copy of a copy — it was hard to find authentic significance in that. It was my first missions trip, and I had not known what to expect. As I hit the road one day; it hit me that perhaps I'm good at not being good. That's not true, of course, because God is good at being good! He reminded me that He is good to His people and He gives good gifts.

During the six-day stint in India, I became God's gift to His people, not so much by imparting my skills or talents, but by just being me and loving the people. Understanding that God is the One who holds the pen took the load off my shoulders. I felt like I could stop striving to be someone that I'm not and He can use a genuinely scripted me to reach out to a group of tribal girls. Travelling far from their homes in the jungle, they were brought to the city for the three-day youth conference our team was involved in. As the environment was somewhat alien to these young ladies, my team and I simply smiled and welcomed them with words of encouragement, gently bridging the prevalent gap of bias between upper and lower caste in India. There was also a moment where God placed me to be a listening ear — for three straight hours! More than 6,000km away from home, I realised that people share the same hurts and that the commonalities actually make it easier to be vulnerable and connect. The subject matter may differ, but a common theme rings : how to manage expectations. Through these deep interactions, I begin to understand that I am good because God is good. He has expertly, perfectly lived His life so that I, "a pen", can be used by Him to write good life stories. My inadequacies are written-off and He receives the glory! Christ is the vine and we are the branches, extended to bear fruits and at the same time, connected to the source of everything. He rose above the gravity of our shortcomings. Apart from Him, we can do nothing.

I'm glad my team and I fully abided in Him. Even the people who were not part of our missions team became valuable and essential branches, donating their guitars and drum sticks for those who needed them. At the end of the day, it did not boil down to our strengths or talents. We were a team. Each person presented a different colour in God's big box of crayons. The willingness to be sharpened while on missions is also an important point. My biggest takeaway is that God is good, all the time; and all the time, God is good. I know for I have tasted His goodness. Although we have our strengths and weaknesses, we were made to be as one body to condiment each other. Let's trust Him as He pours out His 'divine flavour' and 'curry' us through.



THE GOLDEN HEARTS OF MYANMAR

Clad in their colourful 'Li-Su' traditional costumes, the young men and ladies of Myanmar extended a warm welcome to our team. With wide smiles, firm handshakes and a bouquet of fresh flowers for each of us; we felt like VIPs. I had been forewarned by a friend of mine in Singapore, "They are going to treat you like kings and queens. Just receive their hospitality, it is only polite". So true! That welcome ceremony was the beginning of our humbling experience with the Myanmar people, as we received superb Myanmar hospitality and generosity throughout our stay in the golden land of Myanmar.

Our purpose was to train, equip and bring resources to the youth leaders. We conducted one conference for the youth leaders, two youth conferences, four church services and ran a children's programme.

In the past, I never knew how a short trip could make any impact on the locals. I always treated my short term trips as religious holidays, telling myself, "Well Jas, it's just a 7-day trip. You can't make any difference. God will do His thing. Your role is to learn as much as you can from this trip, grow as a global Christian and prepare yourself for a longer term call in future."

However through this trip, I saw the impact short-term trips could make to the locals. They were fascinated as we taught them to play games with built-in biblical learning points. They were also amazed to see how we made learning the Word of God meaning and fun. The local youth leaders would come up to us and say, "That was a good idea! We didn't know things could be done that way! We want to do that again next time!" They picked up many ideas, asked us many questions, asked our pastors for guidance, and diligently took down notes as we shared and gave our feedback. I saw how these young leaders carry a passion and burden to build up their own youth ministries. They wanted to know about the cell structure, about how to organise a sports evangelistic event or how to start a ladies' ministry. We have R-AGE youth leaders as young as 14 years old but in Myanmar, the average age of the youth leaders is 35 years. Hence, most youth leaders we touched base with are professional working adults with their own career to build and families to care for. Nevertheless, they are on fire for God. I am extremely humbled by their childlike, humble and teachable spirit.

What encouraged me greatly was the feedback we received from our Myanmar sisters.

In Myanmar, it is culturally appropriate for men to fill the leadership roles. As our Singaporean ladies conducted the lessons, programmes and games, our Myanmar sisters-in-Christ felt inspired to also step up and lead in their own church, and the young men are supportive to empower their sisters-in-Christ. What a beautiful sight to see the body of Christ at work.

I urge you to sign up for a mission trip! In God's strength and by His grace, prepare with all your heart, mind, soul and strength. It will change your life, as you experience God's grace and love out of your comfort zone. At the same time, your heart will be so blessed as you interact with the brothers and sisters-in-Christ from another country. Their hearts of humility, their hunger for God and their passion to serve in the kingdom of God will certainly touch your heart. In the golden land of Myanmar, our team had truly witnessed a people with a heart of gold.

Introducing Jason Frenn

Jason Frenn has held more than 55 international crusades where more than 3 million people have heard the presentation of the Gospel. He has seen more than 300,000 first time decisions for Christ.

Jason Frenn was born in Los Angeles, CA and lived in Southern California until the age of 24. He and his wife Cindee moved to Costa Rica in 1991, Jason began preaching Holy Spirit Conferences throughout the country. At the end of 1994, they held a crusade in a barrio called Los Cuadros. It was there that the Lord spoke to them and called them to hold open air crusades in Latin America.

Thousands have received healing and many communities have been greatly impacted by the power of God's Word! National newspapers, television and radio networks have given their ministry free publicity and coverage. The crusades have been transmitted live via secular radio. Two television networks have aired their crusades, communicating the Gospel to millions of households. Crowds that once averaged 1,000 in attendance are now averaging 10,000 to 15,000 nightly.

In his book "Purpose Driven Church", Pastor Rick Warren of Saddleback Church in California shared that in order for surfers to surf well, they needed to be always watching out for the direction of waves. Not only so, they would have to BE READY to catch and ride on the waves. Likewise, Christians are like surfers. We do not create the waves. God is the one creating the waves and all we need to do is to CATCH and RIDE on them.

My next question is "Where are God's waves in our times?"

I am a Chinese and I love all Chinese! Hudson Taylor, a great missionary worker from the west gave his life to the Chinese in China. He has a very famous quotation. "If I had a thousand pounds, China should have it. If I had a thousand lives, China should have them. No, not China, but Christ. Can we do too much for Him? Can we do enough for our Precious Saviour?"

In view of Singapore's economic growth, we depend significantly on foreigners coming to us and contributing to the building of our nation. As a result, a lot of foreign Chinese are also coming to Singapore to work and study.

With the belief that God is creating ripples of waves amongst the Chinese, ACES (Aligning Chinese Executives and Students) Ministry seeks to reach out to two main groups of foreign Chinese, namely working professionals or students receiving higher education.
