ALPHA

in both

At Grace Assembly, we started our first Alpha course in July 2012. For the first few years, the Alpha course was held once a year, however, since 2016, the Alpha course was conducted twice a year, at two separate venues, G1 and G2. Over the years, many had invited Jesus to be their Lord and Saviour, while long time Christians became fired up after the course, lives have been transformed as evident by the numerous testimonies in how they had been impacted by the course. The number of seekers have been increasing over the years, as more Gracians are aware of the relational building Alpha course, and had invited their family members and colleagues to attend.

Over the years, there have been an increasing number of Chinese speaking participants who attended the English Alpha course. Some came with numerous questions teeming in their minds and had gotten their answers from the video teaching. Many had come to know the Lord, however, the participants were not so involved in the discussion due to language barrier. There was also feedback from Gracians, who are concerned over the salvation of their pre believing parents, relatives or even colleagues who could only converse in Chinese, and requested if we could conduct Alpha in Chinese.

With all these in consideration, together with the Chinese ministry, we will be conducting the Alpha course at G1 starting in end February, in both English and Chinese.

What is Alpha course?

Alpha is a 15 session introduction to the Christian faith. It is designed primarily for non church goers and new Christians. It is a simple and effective tool for evangelism that mobilizes lay people to welcome anyone interested to find out more about the Christian faith.

Alpha has its appeal because it is non threatening. It creates an environment where participants are free to speak their minds and still be accepted. This is important considering Alpha's target audience, some of whom may have had unpleasant experiences with Christianity.

The 15 sessions are carried out over 10 weeks (12 weeks in total including introduction and celebration), a participant is free to leave at any time. This frees a person from being coerced into becoming a Christian, and leaves him more receptive to the discussions on Christian life.

The session will be held on Friday evenings and each session begins with a meal. The meal serves to set participants at ease and helps them to get to know each other. After the meal, the participants are invited to a live talk or a video. The participants are then broken into small groups where they listen to one another, discuss and learn more about the Christian faith and life issues. No question is considered too simple or hostile.

In the middle of the course, participants are invited to attend a weekend retreat, Alpha Weekend Away, where they are given the opportunity to have an experience with the Holy Spirit in a guided session. Members of the group usually grow closer after the weekend.

What can I do ?

Be intentional, pray and ask the Lord to show you who you can invite for the course. You may want to preempt your guests so they can make plans to keep their Friday evenings free.

You can also serve in this evangelistic ministry as group facilitator, befriender, prayer intercessor, set up, audio/visual or administration.

A Peep into the Wholeness Ministry Testimony Booklet

Do you constantly love your spouse but only to find that you quarrel, insult and hurt each other? Are there issues in your life that prevent you from experiencing the abundant life that Jesus has promised? Read on to see how God has delivered this sister from her past. When you are free, you are free indeed.

For the past 20 years, my husband and I are always arguing and quarrelling due to our different upbringing, opinions and principles. We didn't know that unconsciously we formed ungodly beliefs of each other and we always thought that "I am right and the other party is wrong." As a result, we opened the doors to negative family patterns and having ungodly soul ties with each other.

We insulted and hurt each other so much so that we hardened our hearts towards each other and we hardly communicated. Thank God for the Wholeness Ministry, we identified each of our own generational patterns and ungodly beliefs.

God has changed both of us by praying for each other (in the past, my husband had never wanted to pray together with me), confessing our sins to each other, and forgiving one another. We are now more united mentally, socially, emotionally & spiritually. We respect each other's opinions and principles and will work out any differences by talking and coming to a compromise.

Imagine being hit by the 3D's – Depression, Divorce and Death. This sister was depressed to the extent of having to be admitted in hospital. If our God can break this yoke of bondage for her, He can do it for you if you believe. Read on to witness this life-changing miracle.

In 2013, I fell into depression and was hospitalized at the Institute of Mental Health for treatment. I lost interest in living and was suicidal. I was constantly drawn to pick up books or watch YouTube videos on Death. I felt heavily-oppressed in my spirit. I also felt spiritually weak and lethargic even though I was attending church. Death of loved ones and divorce drove me to depression. I was at the end of my road. I cried out to Christ to rescue me. In 2016, the breakthroughs came.

I was on my way to meet an old friend for dinner at Star Vista and I saw an art piece hanging in the middle of a furniture shop, with these lines: "Be still and know that I am God. I will restore you." That evening, I became terribly upset when I reached home, as I was still hurting from my past. The Holy Spirit knew beforehand that I would have an emotional breakdown and reminded me of the verse I saw at the shop that night: "Be still and know that I am God. I will restore you." That brought a lot of comfort to know God cares.

My obsession on the topic of death was gone. I no longer felt 'heavy' and oppressed in my spirit. During the session, Jesus took away my shame and guilt. Love, joy, peace, hope, confidence, security and self-control entered my heart. I no longer feel 'chained'. I feel a new 'freedom' to move forward and pursue a future in my job and in my life. My mind became clear and I seemed to have more energy. I was able to focus on my job better, embrace more activities, became less fearful and was able to solve my problems well. God has healed me at a deeper level where counselling, psychiatric treatment, self-help books and self-talk could not reach me. The yolk of slavery was broken by the power of God. He broke my chains and set me free from my bondage, turned my sorrow into joy, took my burden and gave me rest. I felt alive once again.

The transformation is authentic and lasting.



Are you desperate to see your child saved and accept Jesus?

A mother who has been praying for her adult son shares a powerful testimony of how her son miraculously escaped injury and death and came out scratch-free. He lost control of the car and crashed into a traffic light post only later to receive conviction in his heart.

We experienced God's divine help and intervention in our youngest son's life. He has been rebellious, and backslidden from God. Meanwhile, we have always been praying to God to change him and bring him back into His fold. A situation arose when he was driving home in the morning and somehow he lost control of the car and crashed into a traffic light post. The front bonnet of the car was completely wrecked but God, who is full of love, mercy and compassion preserved my son's life that even the paramedics were utterly surprised when they came and found not a single bruise on him.

I remembered it was a Sunday morning when he woke up around 3am, trembling and crying in fear, and going down on his knees to ask for God's forgiveness. We were happy that he received this revelation and hope this will be a reminder to him to come back to the Lord.



UPDATES FROM OUR MISSIONARY IN SINGKAWANG


New ground was broken in July 2017 when we held the inaugural service of our bilingual Hakka / Mandarin church plant — the first of its kind under the Assemblies of God (AG) umbrella in Singkawang. It is also the first Chinese AG church in the province of West Kalimantan. Singkawang distinguishes itself from the rest of Indonesia in that 70% of the population are Chinese. Most of them are steeped in the traditions of idol and ancestral worship, and a quick glimpse around is all you need to see why Singkawang is also known as the City of a Thousand Temples. With this knowledge, there arise a great urgency to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ among the local Chinese community, and this was our motivation as we pioneered this church.

In the weeks leading up to the commencement of the church, we visited the homes of the local Chinese families in the neighbourhood to get to know them and invite them to attend our service. So far we have around 6 families coming for our services and we are planning more events in the future to reach out to the locals in greater numbers.

The missions ground is here in Singkawang is tough. We know from the Bible, however, that when believers come together with one heart and one mind, by the power of Holy Spirit, God can move in marvellous ways.

Consider the missionary that started Grace Assembly of God. Do you think he ever imagined that our church would grow from its humble beginnings to such a size? Look at us now! No one can conceive of the great work His almighty hands can achieve if He is the One who wills it into being. We must remember the words of Jesus in Matthew 19:26 — “With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.”

We have chosen to press on and undertake this pioneering project of the bilingual Hakka/Mandarin church under the umbrella of Grace Missions because we want to see the gospel reach the ends of the world. Please pray with us as we share the good news of Jesus Christ with the residents of the place we now call home, that we may all come together as one voice to worship the King of kings!



INTERNSHIP WITH GRACE MISSIONS BY GABRIELLE ONG

During my final year in the university, I had a growing desire to embark on a longer term missions trip and toyed with the idea of taking a 'gap year'. In seeking God regarding my impending graduation and what to do after, I was reminded of my childhood desire to be a missionary. Around that time, I attended a Gap4God session and found out about the internship offered by Grace Missions (GM).

The GM internship appealed to me greatly, especially the tail-end field experience in West Kalimantan, Indonesia. I have taken several Bahasa Indonesian language modules in the university and I was working on a project with Indonesian domestic workers at a research think-tank during my school break. I enjoyed that and furthered the project by working on it as my Final Year Honours Thesis. The Indonesia 'outfield' portion of the internship and my growing desire to explore what missions work looks like seemed to point to this internship as a proper 'next step'.

I heard from several friends that parental objection was a big part of their gap year experiences. Yet surprisingly what I received was encouraging support from my family and spiritual leaders. Other signs of affirmation followed and I sensed that God was nudging me toward taking on the internship. I decided to go for it and I was later accepted for the position.

I have just finished the first phase of my internship where I shadowed pastors, set up a library for the Missions Corner at GII, went for short term mission trips and learned more about GM's key thrusts to plant churches, prepare leaders and propel people. I am now in the second phase of my internship where I will be based in Thailand for a 6-week cross-cultural training program. I will return to Singapore for a fortnight in early October and thereafter set off for Singkawang in West Kalimantan, Indonesia for a 2-month stint.

During this period of internship, I seek your prayer covering. Please pray

- For spiritual covering, overall well-being and physical protection in my coming in and going out, especially as I am out alone in the mission field.
- For me to walk in deeper intimacy with God and that my eyes will be opened to witness the work that He is doing in me, through me and around me.
- That God will stretch me and help me to adapt, absorb and enjoy as I embark on the stay-in cross-cultural training program.
- For God's anointing to be upon me and that I would be effective help to the ministry Caleb Khoo is doing in Singkawang.
- That God would make straight the path before me and embolden me to follow after Him.


