ENTHRONING THE KING!

As one of our five main key thrusts, it is a fitting reminder that we worship an Extraordinary God. This is important because the call of the Missional Family Church does not begin with the task at hand but with the centrality of God.

The distinguishing mark of the Church is not in the things we do (the *what*) nor in their motivation (the *why*) but in the object (the *Who*) of our worship. Our acts of love must flow from our obedience of God. Otherwise we will be no different from the many social enterprises that are doing good work with noble intentions.

As Grace moves into becoming the Missional Family Church we have to be defined in our most fundamental role, that is, as worshippers, and rediscover what our God requires of us in worship. In centring our worship we recover our identity and calling as His church.

To ensure that this does happen, we have to deliberately:-

- Make Worship, not the Worship Service, the goal of church life. Worship needs to move from 1.5 hours a week (or the 30 minutes of congregational singing in a service) to a daily time in worship and communing with the Lord's presence;
- Make Worship, an activity not external to but inherent in our renewed nature. Worship needs to be a habit that is personally cultivated not depending on or relegating to a worship leader and team;
- Move Worship from a tired rut to meaningful ritual. Worship needs to be in the Spirit and in Truth;
- Move Worship from a standpoint of consumers to operationally ready disciples. Worshippers need to realize that they are not on a cruise-ship (*placing orders*) but on a battleship (*taking orders*).

Worship must move from the mindset of *what* we do (our **expression**) to *why* we live (our **motivation**) the way we live (our DNA) because of *who*(se) we are (our **identity**).



BICC176: FOUNDATION OF CHRISTIAN COUNSELING

A FATHER - Do they need one? Or Google can do it?

Dysfunctional — not behaving or working normally. A family with both parents can be dysfunctional. Association with dysfunctional families are usually with single-parents, children with abusive caregivers or missing father. Core issue according to a research done over the last five years with a missing father model includes uninvolved and emotionally detached figures that sets off a suppressed and hidden wound that would later manifest itself in adolescent and young adult years.

We may run a corporation, head a team of high caliber individuals in our respective career's, but as individuals, we are constantly looking for an identity as to who we are and what we stand for.

What about these grown up adolescents packed with adrenalin, now ready to go out but struggle to identify themselves with the society because they were not ready nor equipped. If the father model is present but not providing guidance, where would they turn to for answers? The internet? Their peers? When these important life lessons are outsourced to society to define, we need to know the risk it entails.

Recall who is ruling the world now until He comes. If you do not take a stand he will gladly stand in your place and lead them away from God's intend and design.

This century is marked by remarkable technology feats and advancement. Most information of the world was brought about by newspaper and radio. Today, fingers are hardly stained from newspaper and who listens to radio, apart from driving?

The dangers of a missing father model takes its toll further on. How does a man know he is a man? What really is a real man when dad says "Be a man!" Does holding a cigarette make me a man?

For a girl, it may impact how they define love and consequentially marriage. For instance, in Meg Meer's book "Strong Fathers, Strong Daughter" it details accounts of teen pregnancy and why girls would willingly submit to their boyfriend's request.


If a girl has never been treated attentively and lovingly by her father nor has she seen these affectionate acts from her father to her mother, while the only words

she did hear were disrespectful words, without proper guidance she would soon develop a frame of mind on how she ought to be treated and consider it normal since she grew up seeing and hearing these.

A day comes, when a man comes along and courts her with affection and constantly praises her. Would she perceive it as love she never felt before? And thinks that he is finally the one for her? What if his intentions are incorrect and she is unable to perceive it and he leaves her after his desires are fulfilled? Will she ever be hopeful of a man again? Or would she start thinking that she is not good enough?

In this session, we will discuss and explore the impact of a missing fatherhood in the household and its effect from children's lives (their identity, their values) to social issues.




This story retells the story of Samson (Judges 15-16).



FATHERS' WORKSHOP THE WORLD NEEDS A FATHER

Do you agree that it is much easier to become a father than to be one?

Boys need to be prepared for manhood. Young men will be fathers one day. And fathers need help to provide proper leadership to their families. Fathers must be restored to their God-given place as servant-leaders of their families and their communities.

The 'World Needs a Father' is a movement seeking to help men move from being generally passive as fathers to being the role models God intended them to be. It aims to equip fathers to be God's representatives in authority, identity, security and validation within the family structure.

The 'World Needs a Father' in Grace Assembly consists of 4 modules as follows:

1. A Father's role in his Family
2. A Father confers Identity
3. A Father establishes Moral Authority
4. A Father provides Security and affirms Potential

Each module has three teaching sessions and follow up sessions on the practicum. All modules are held quarterly throughout the year.

You may participate in any of the 4 modules so that if you miss one module, you can move to the next one. In other words, own time own target! While you don't have to finish all the modules in the first cycle, you are encouraged to complete all 4 modules eventually.







SERVING THE ROHINGYA REFUGEES IN BANGLADESH

In December 2017, our team from Grace Missions had the opportunity to serve the Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh. We visited the Kutupalong refugee camp site in Cox Bazar during the second part of our journey.

Since August 2017, over 900,000 Rohingyas, an ethnic minority group in Myanmar, have fled from the violence in the Rahkine state to the border of Bangladesh where they are currently camping as refugees. Although there has been an influx of international aid, the need for aid is still overwhelming as the camp is the largely overpopulated.

Despite the tight control by the Bangladeshi military, we thank God that we managed to gain approval for entry. We partnered with a few local ministers who acted as our guides and translators during our interactions with the refugees. Some of the refugees also welcomed us into their make-shift homes where they shared about their problems and allowed us to pray for them.

In one particular household, an elderly woman was sharing with us that she has been paralysed for years and could not walk. The team took the chance to pray for her legs. After praying, we helped her to stand and she was able to take a few steps! It was a faith-growing moment for the team and a moment of opportunity for the household to encounter Jesus.

Apart from praying for some of the refugees, we also provided basic first-aid by dressing open wounds and helping to trim the nails of the locals. Some of the youths on our team also connected with the local children through song and dance, bringing smiles to the children's faces. As the weather was getting colder, we prepared warm clothing that went into the relief aid bags for distribution to the refugees.

Although the time spent with the refugees was short, we were thankful that we got to listen to their concerns and needs. We thought of future arrangements such as building more toilets and improving the ongoing lack of sanitation. Through our small acts of service, we pray that the Lord will use us to bless the refugees. It is our prayer that our trip there would raise awareness about this on-going crisis.



BRINGING THE MESSAGE OF JESUS TO MYANMAR

Jesus says in Matthew 9:37 that “the harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few.”

Taking that to heart, my Koinonia Grace Missional Group took courage, armed ourselves with love and went forth as a team to Myanmar sharing the gospel and our testimonies in churches, gospel rallies and in the homes we visited in the outskirts of Yangon. We also shared at bible schools. Our team sensed the presence of God with us in everything we did in the trip. The cohesiveness, unity and team work we experienced... wow, it got to be divine! We were amazed by how God worked in the midst of us!

We gave out gifts, prayed for healing, financial need and blessings among many other things. During one of the home visits, an elderly lady claimed to be always sick in body given her high blood pressure. We shared our testimonies on God’s healing and without us asking, she told us that she wanted to accept Jesus and be led in the sinner’s prayer. We

were amazed.

During two other gatherings in villages, after we shared our testimonies and the gospel, all villagers stood up wanting to receive Jesus into their lives. By the end of our trip, the salvation count was at 160. All glory to God!

By the grace of God, one of the sisters in our team experienced healing in her knees. She is now totally healed and does not need to go for knee cap replacement. This is a real icing on the cake. We went with the intention to bless the people and now the blessing of the Lord flowed on to us as well.

We are dumbfounded by the grace of our Lord. Indeed as the Psalmist says in Psalm 28:7 — “The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and he helps me. My heart leaps for joy, and with my song I praise him.”




