BINT560 Life & Teachings of Paul

20-22 April

Professor: Dr Jerry Horner

This module studies the life, conversion, and travels of the Apostle Paul based on the biblical evidence from the Book of Acts and his Epistles with the understanding of his teachings to the early churches established during his missionary journeys that are applicable to us in the present day applications.

He is the author of many books and articles in theological and educational journals, commentaries, biblical encyclopedias and dictionaries.

BIBT301 Evangelism & Discipleship


Professor: Dr Robert Coleman

This module gives insight into the Great Commission, traces the strategy of Jesus' personal ministry on evangelism and the practical examples of discipleship present in the Bible. An emphasis is placed on the basic New Testament principles of communicating Christ, and the engagement of the world with a coherent gospel through the power of the Holy Spirit. Individuals are challenged and guided to become effective missional witnesses and disciplers in the fulfillment of the mandate.

Dr Robert Coleman is the distinguished professor of Evangelism & Discipleship at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary. Prior to this, he was Director of the School of World Mission & Evangelism at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School while also serving as Ministry Associate of the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association. He is a founding member of the Lausanne Committee for World Evangelism. His best known work, The Master Plan of Evangelism, has sold multiple millions of copies and is being read in over 100 languages.

OVERVIEW

GRACE Missional College, to be inaugurated in 2016, is a joint-collaboration with Christian Life Educators Network-Christian Life School of Theology Global (CLEN-GLST) and Oral Roberts University (ORU) in partnership with ICM Plus Ltd (ICM+).

CLEN-GLST is a membership network of independent schools, instructors and students providing standardized Bible-based education to equip and empower students around the world for Christian education and ministry training.

ORU establishes the accredited program to complement the educational ministries of the local church for the equipping of saints for ministry.

GRACE Missional College organized under the vision and direction of New GRACE, encapsulates core values of the Missional Family Church into the curriculum to realize its desired strategy and outcomes.

GMC, in short, aims to empower and equip leaders, lay ministers, interns, ministry staff, those with full-time calling, and Gracians who are keen, to be trained and developed with the Word and practical ministry skills to lead an intentional missional life.

CURRICULUM

Two specialized categories, Christian Ministry and Christian Missions, for short-term certificate and diploma in theological studies are adapted from the curriculum programs between CLEN-GLST and ORU.

Short-term certificate is a 19-credit program (5 modules), including 1-hour practicum. Diploma of theological studies is a 33-credit program (10 modules), including 3-hour practicum.

Bachelor in theological studies will be offered to those who have successfully completed and graduated with the Diploma of theological studies.

PRACTICUM

The practicum is shaped with the goal to equip people to live missionally.

Students will be involved with missional activities; including local and overseas short-term missions.

TEACHING FACULTY

Professors from CLEN-GLST and ORU are scheduled to teach the modules.

MODE OF INSTRUCTION

The module is made available live and through DVD and facilitated by the lecturers/instructors, or special short course or seminar for the students.

Each 3-credit module must have 37.5 instructional hours. 11-12 hours will be done during the intensive modular or seminar formats. The remaining hours will be supplemented with DVD/video instructional materials, individual reading requirements, assignments, tests and final examination.

REQUIREMENTS

3 credits will be granted when the students have satisfactorily completed the assignments and examination in a module.

A grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 must be achieved in order to receive a certificate or diploma. A GPA of 3.0 is required for student who desires to move on to the Degree program.

Ministerial experience credit units could be awarded to the deacons, teachers and leaders. This is reviewed on an individual basis in terms of their ministerial/ministry involvement.

Students who want to participate in the classes but do not want to take the modules for credit may audit the classes at a fee.

The bi-semester is from January to May and from July to November.
